The CAE, conferred by the American Society of Association Executives (ASAE), is the highest professional credential in the association industry.

To be designated as a Certified Association Executive, an applicant must have experience with nonprofit organization management, complete a minimum of 100 hours in specialized professional development, pass a stringent examination in association management, and pledge to uphold a code of ethics. To maintain the certification, individuals must undertake ongoing professional development and activities in association and nonprofit management. Christine is one of 322 professionals globally to earn the designation in the last year and joins more than 4,500 association professionals who currently hold the CAE credential. The CAE Program is accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA).

Christine has worked in the area of operations for close to 20 years serving as a game day supervisor for guest services for the NFL Washington Football Team, the Dean of Admissions at The Catholic University of America and the Chief of Staff in the Office of Postsecondary Education at the US Department of Education. Christine joined NDAA in 2018 and her focus is on employee engagement, strategic initiatives, change management, compliance standards, marketing, and cross-functional team operations.
