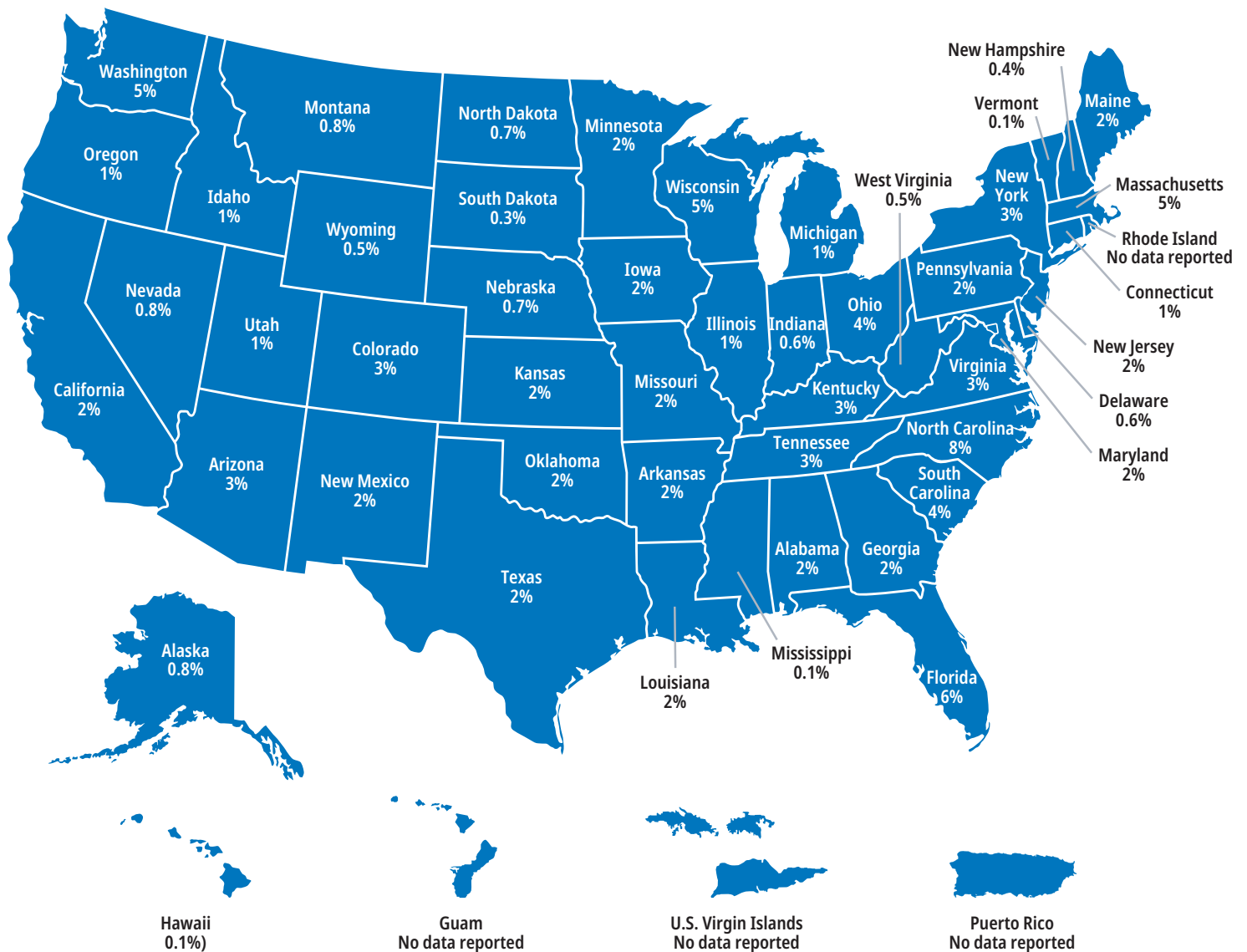

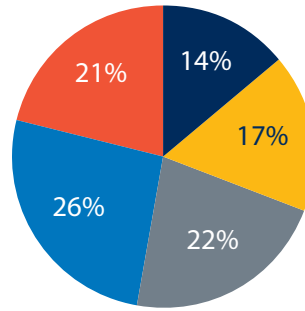

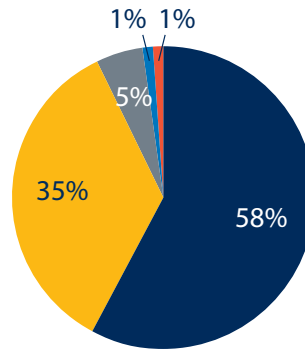

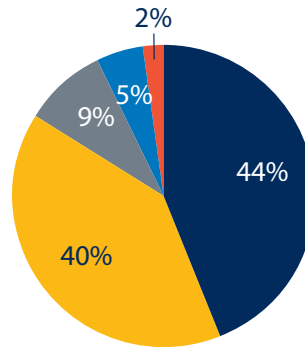
Q3. Without regard to your current employment, you enjoy being a prosecutor.

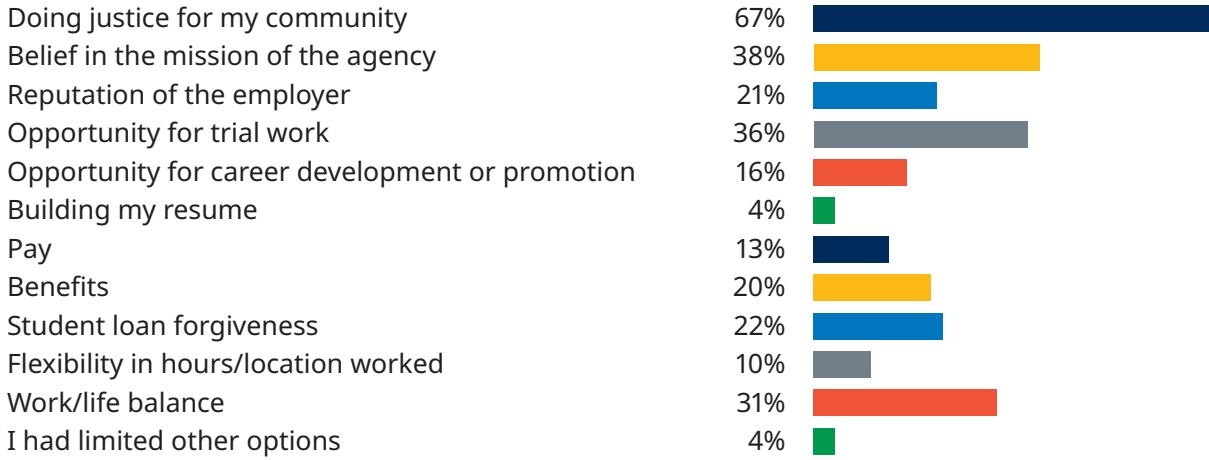

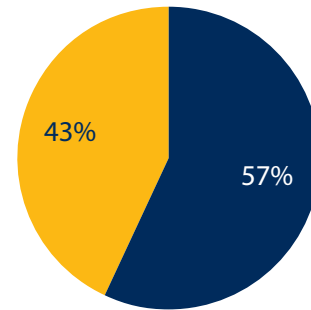
Q5. What were the most important factors in deciding to work for your current employer?

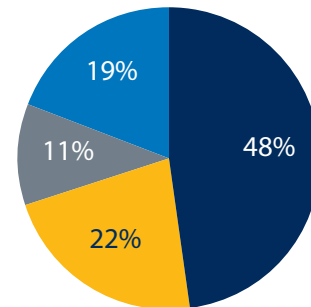

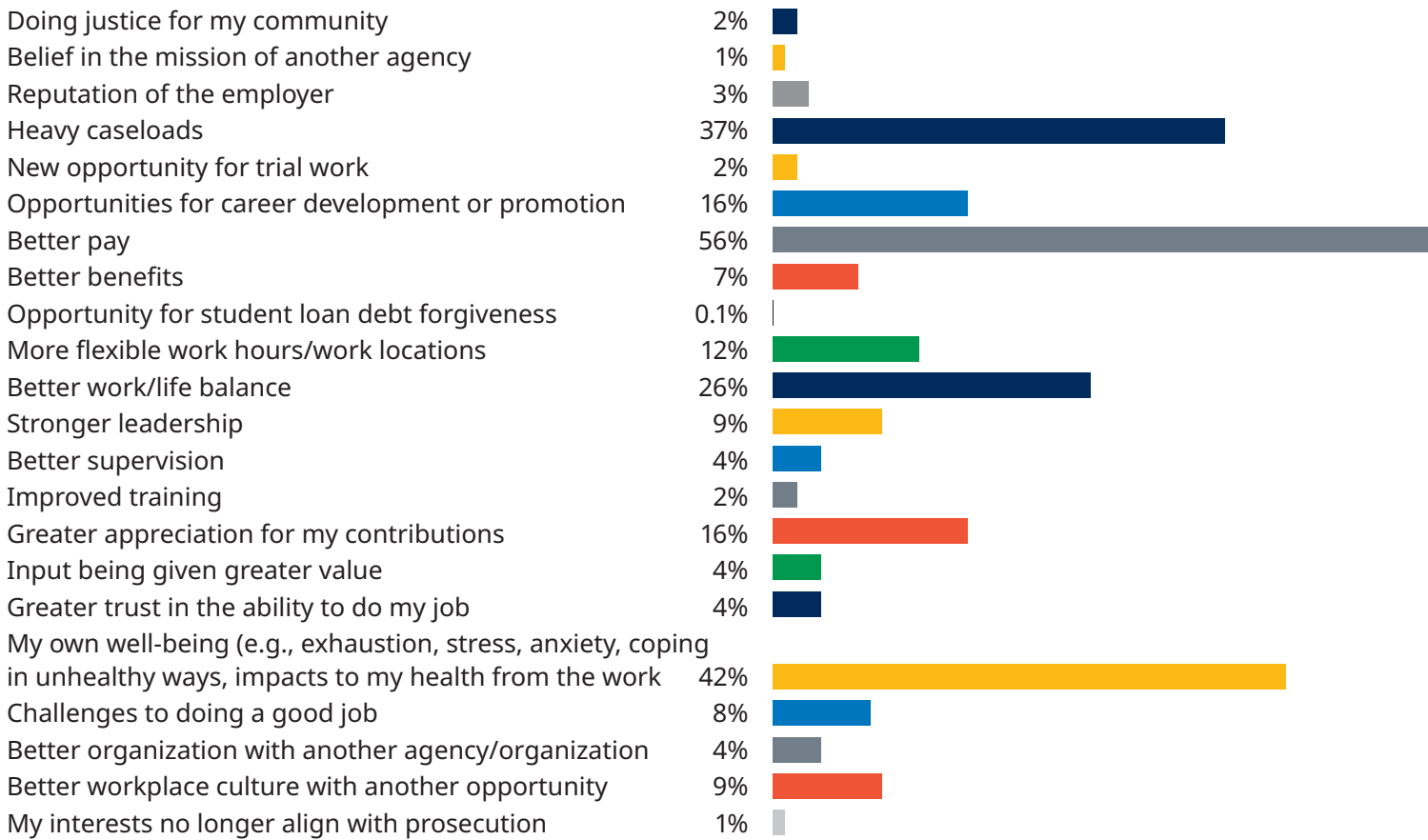

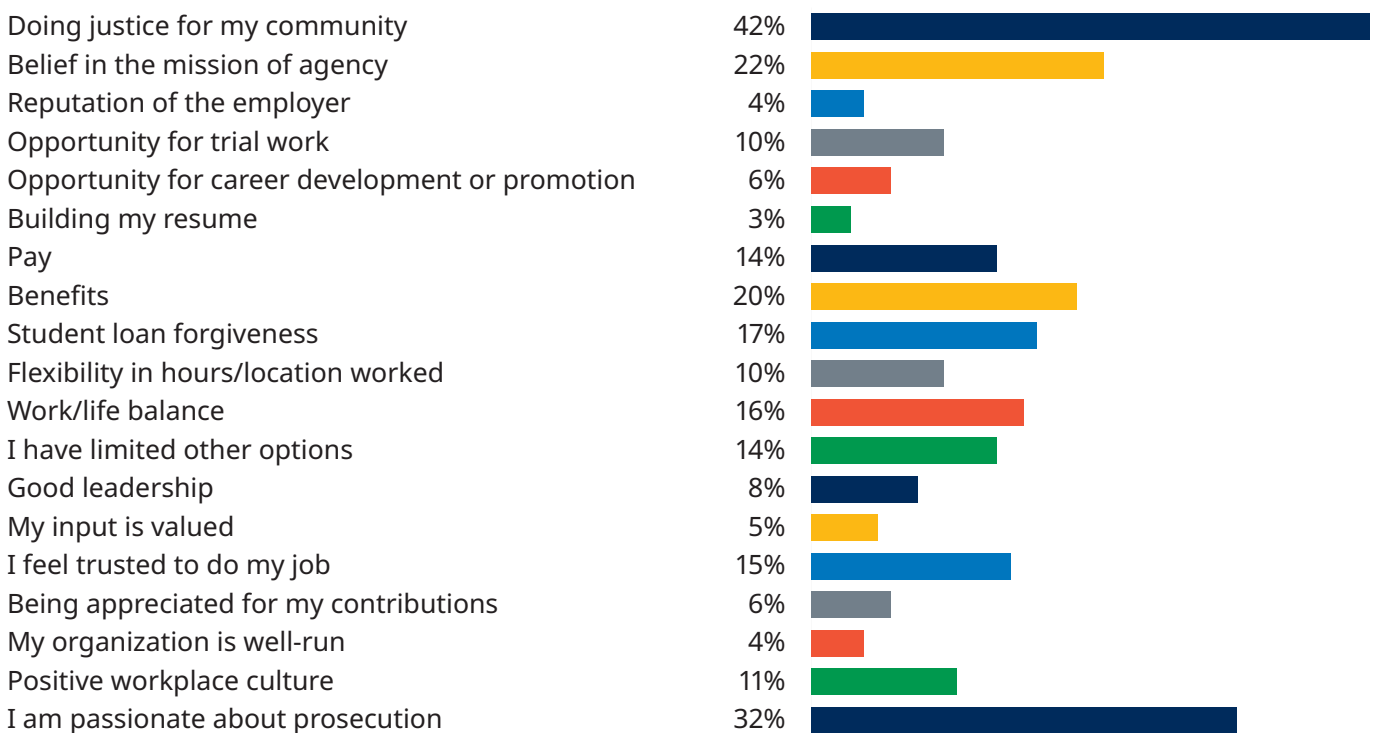
Q8. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

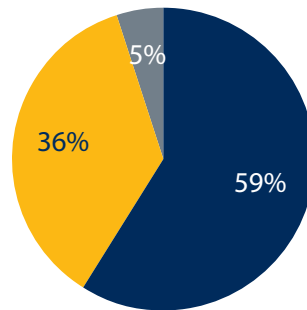

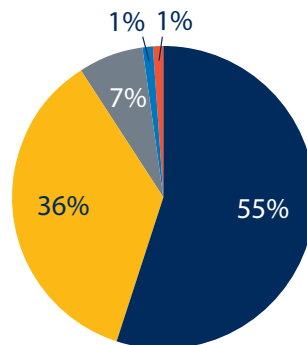

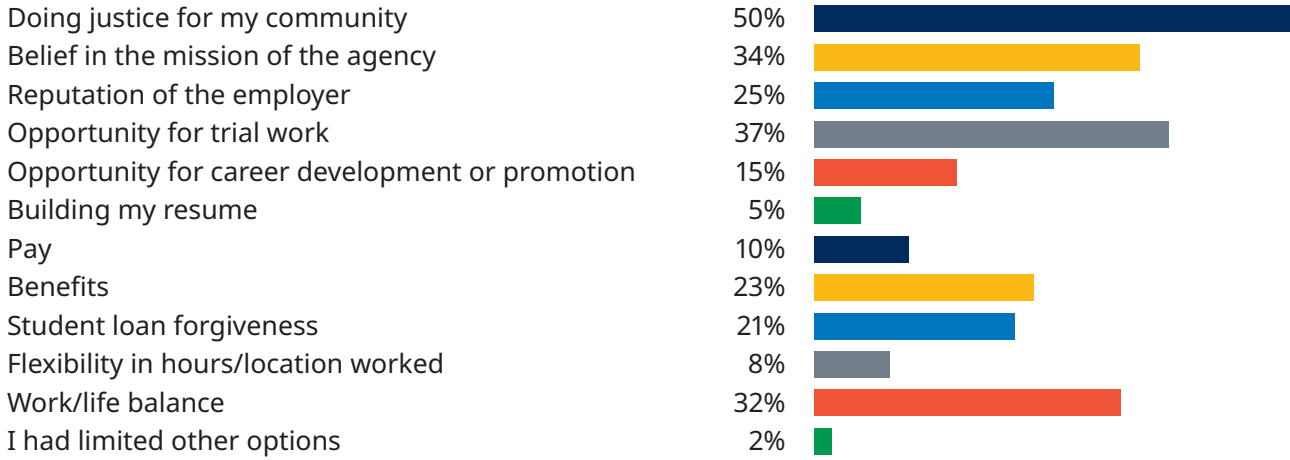

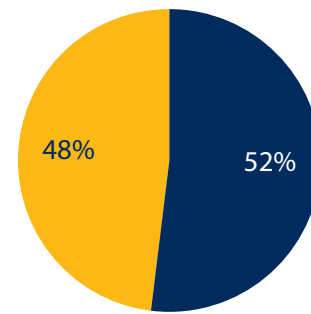

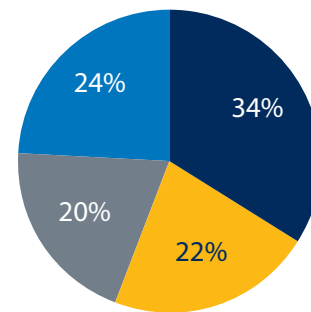

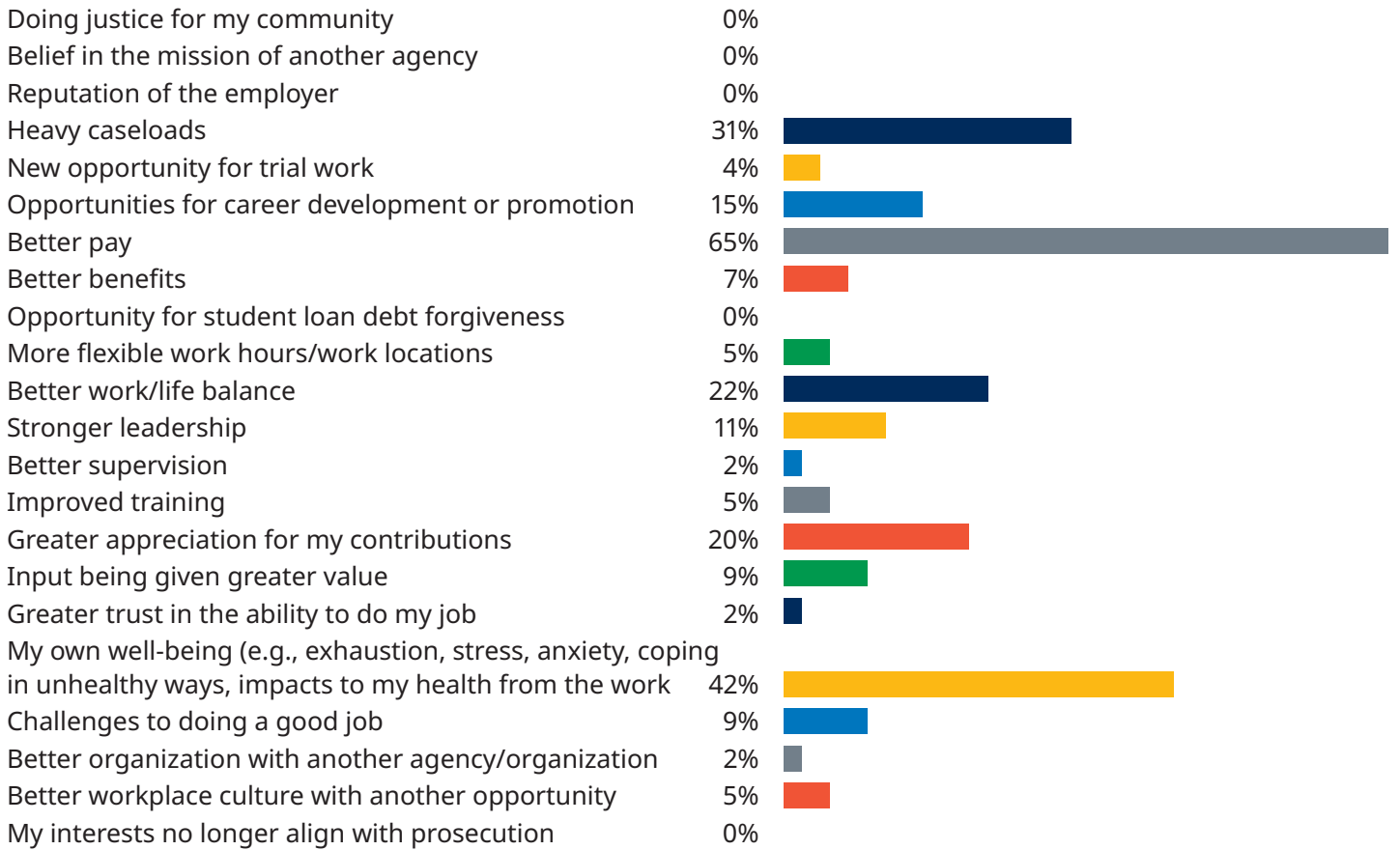

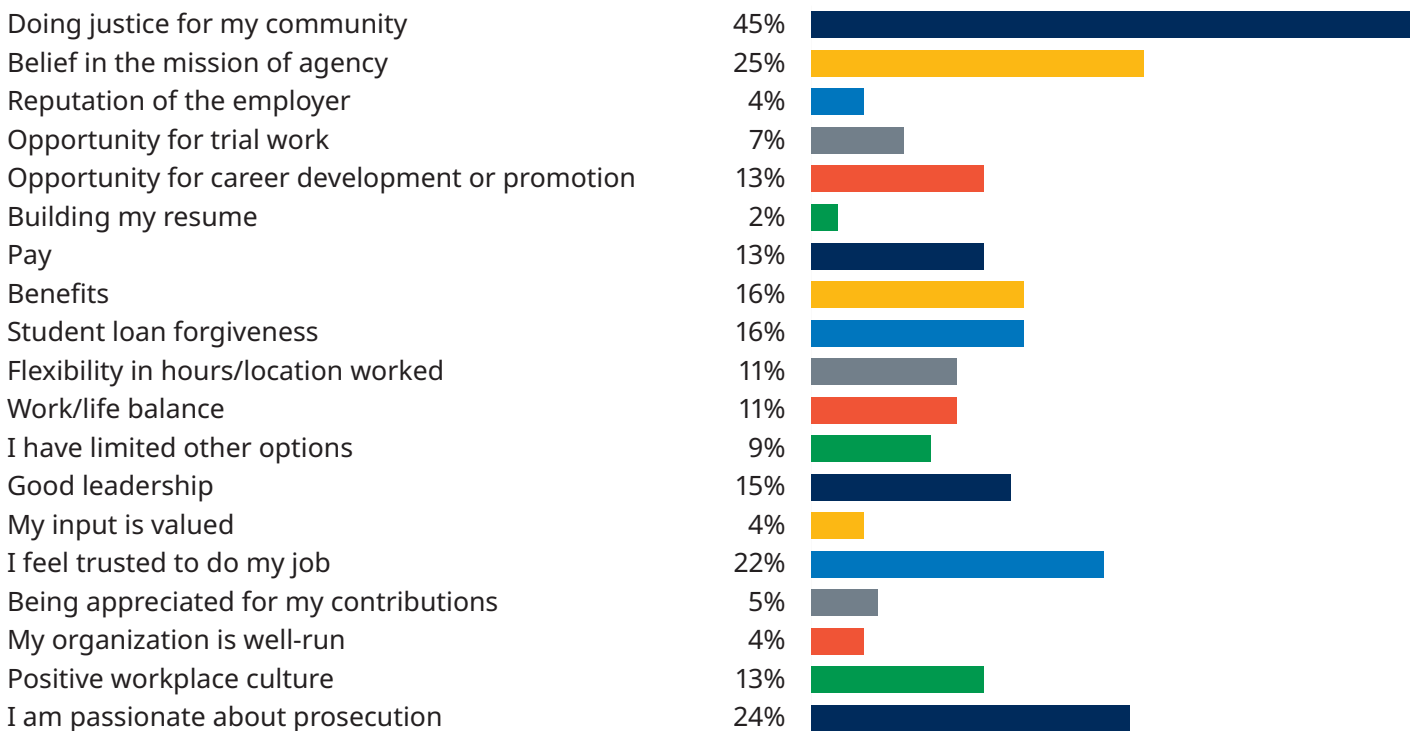
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

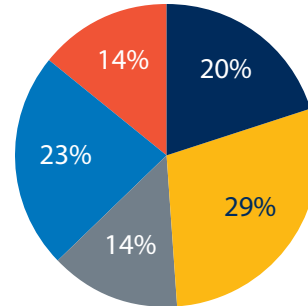

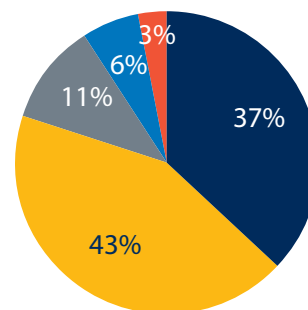

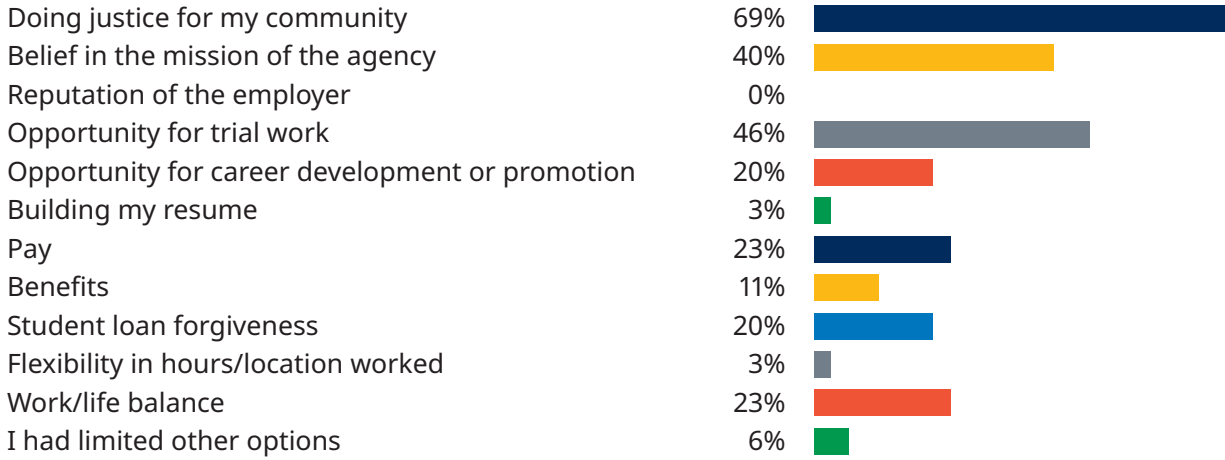

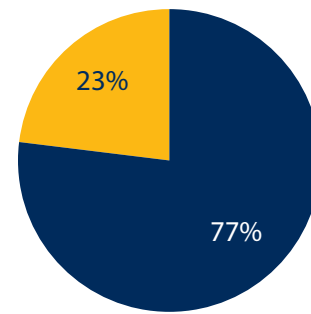

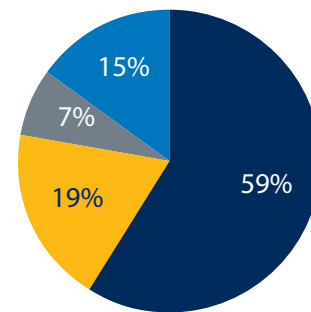

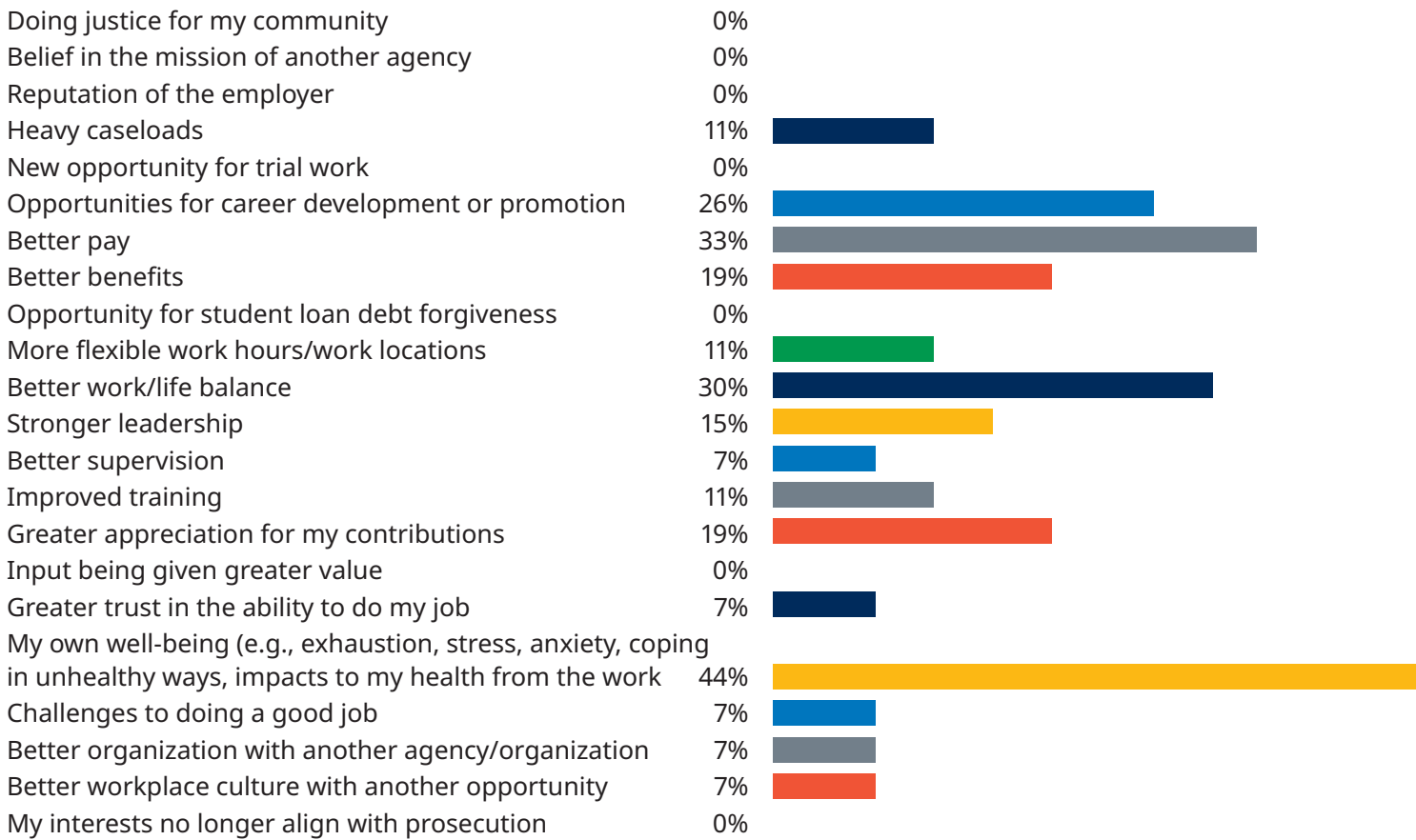

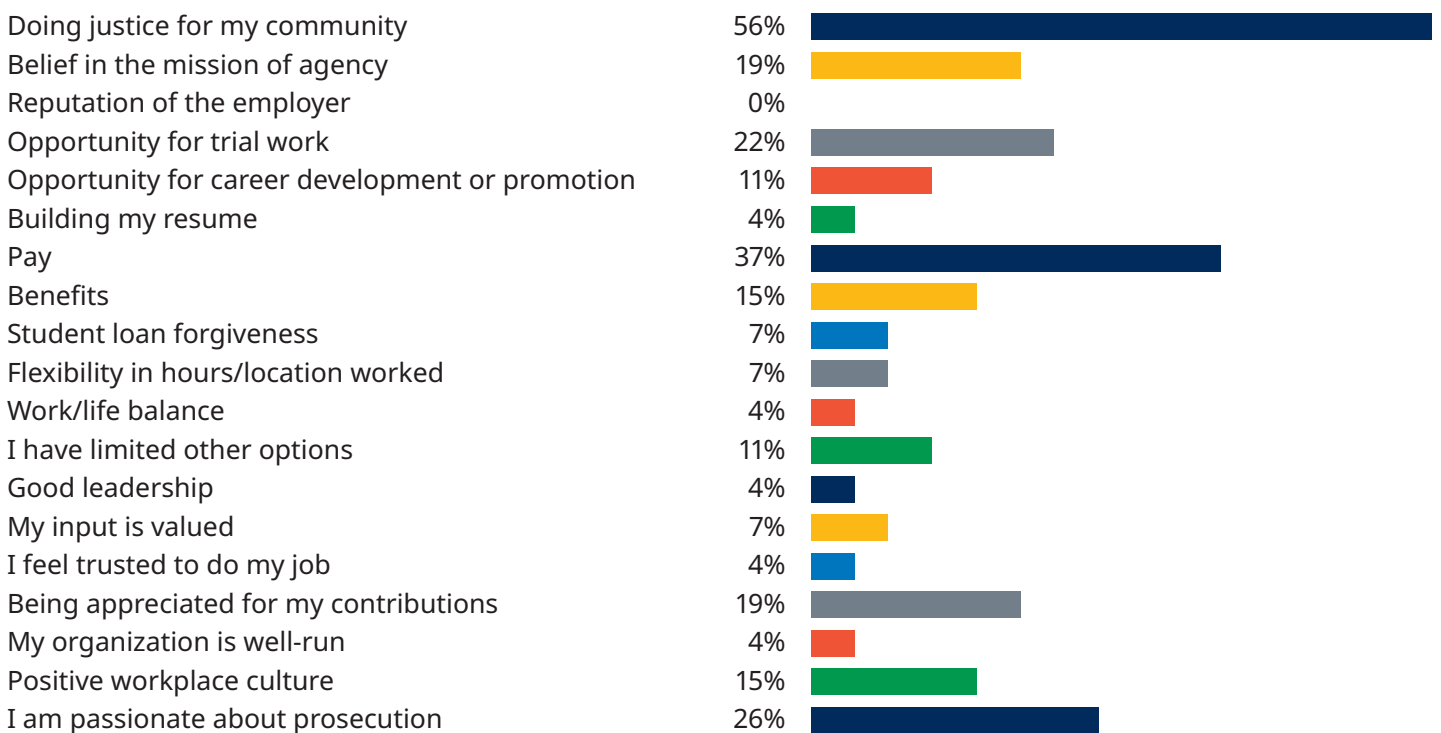
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

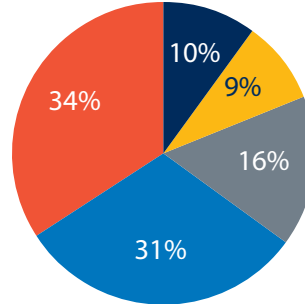

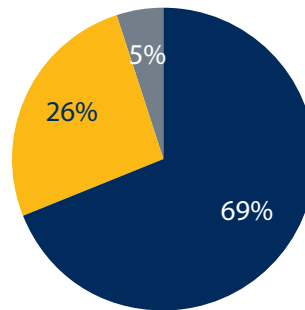

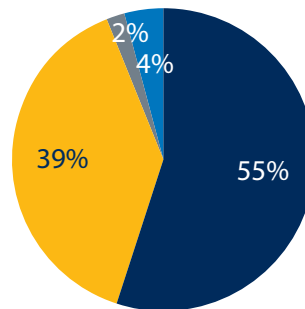

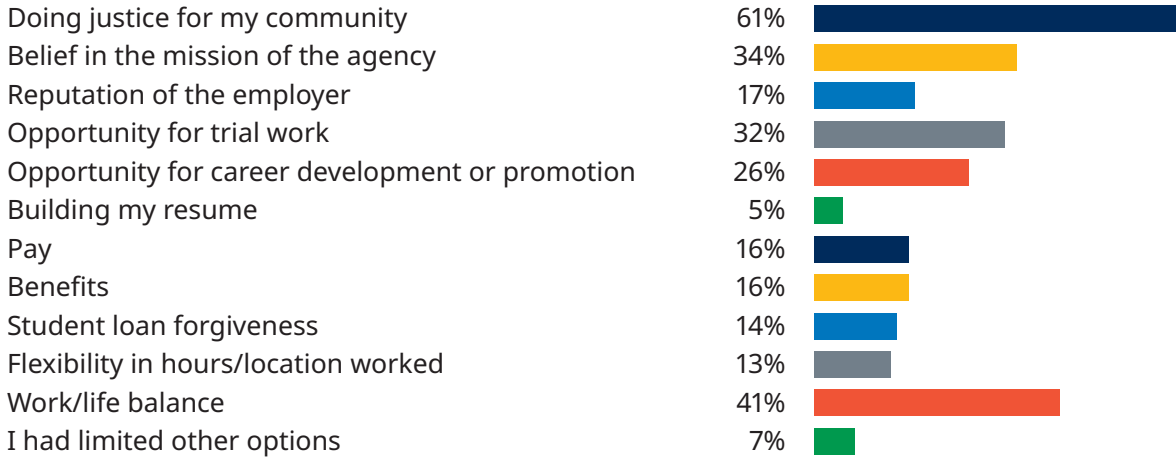

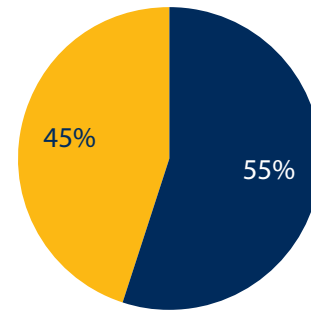

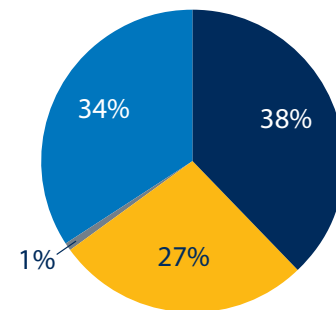

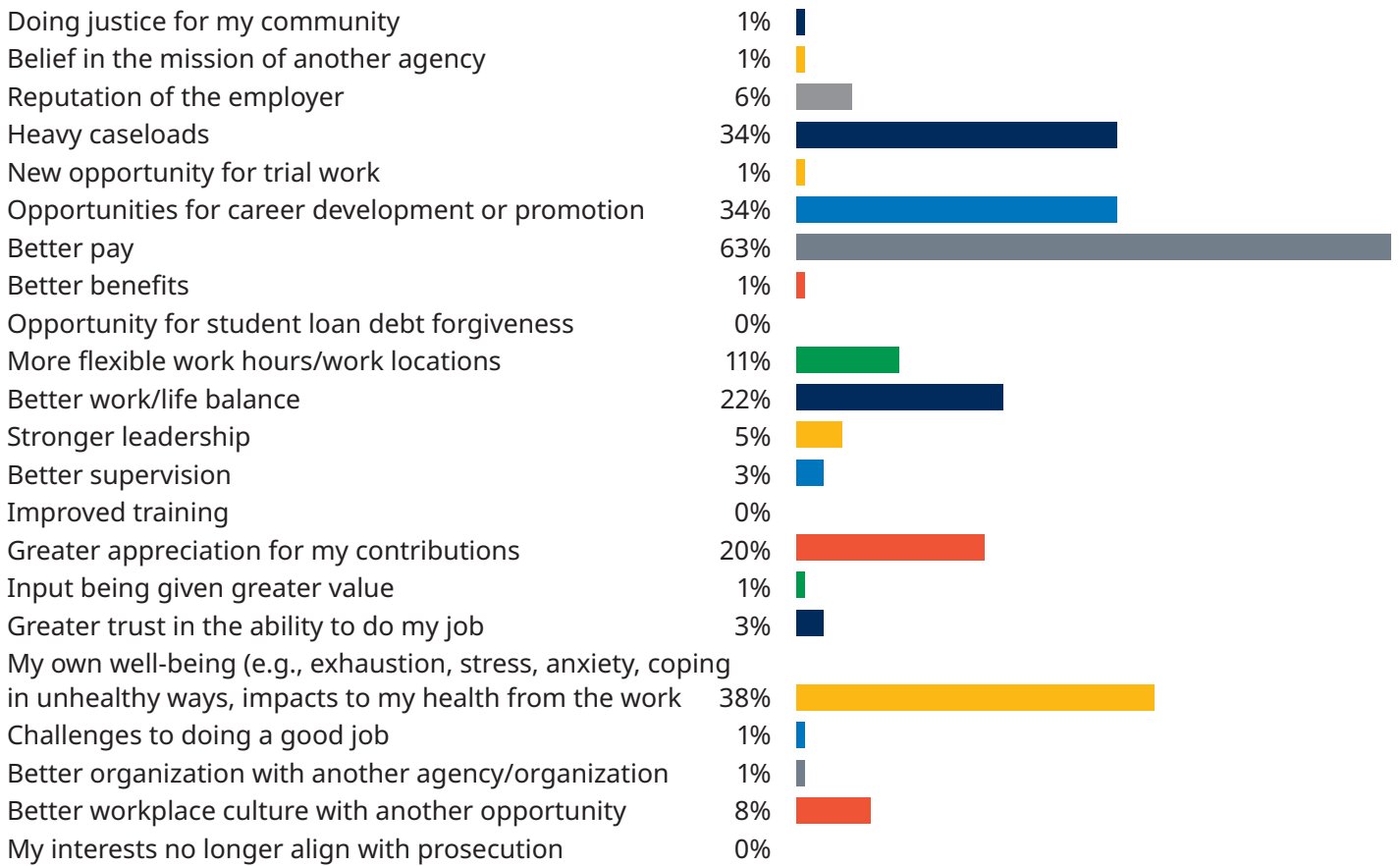

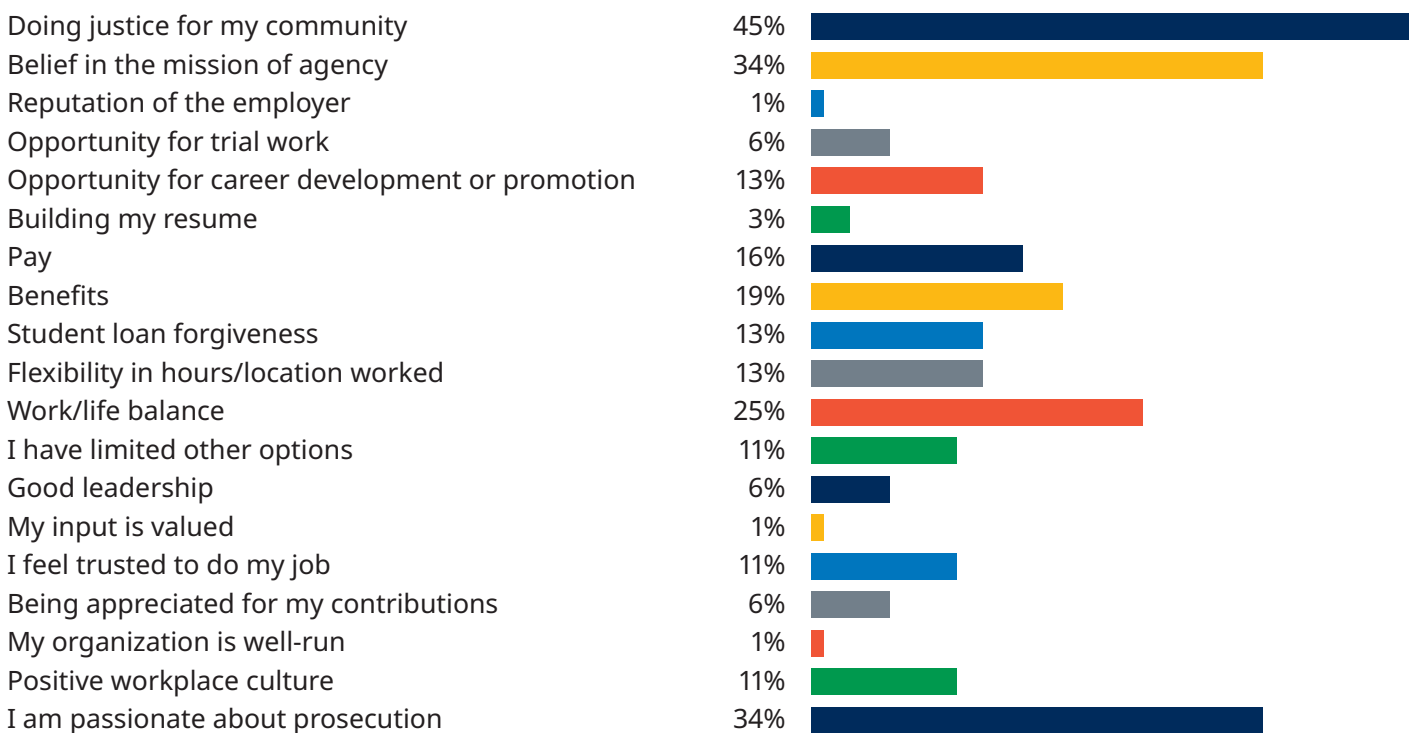
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

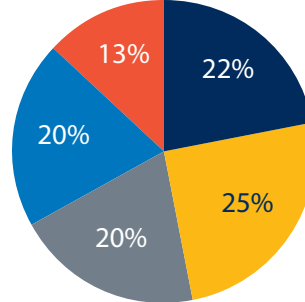

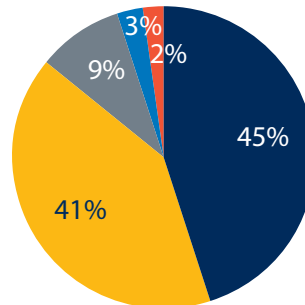

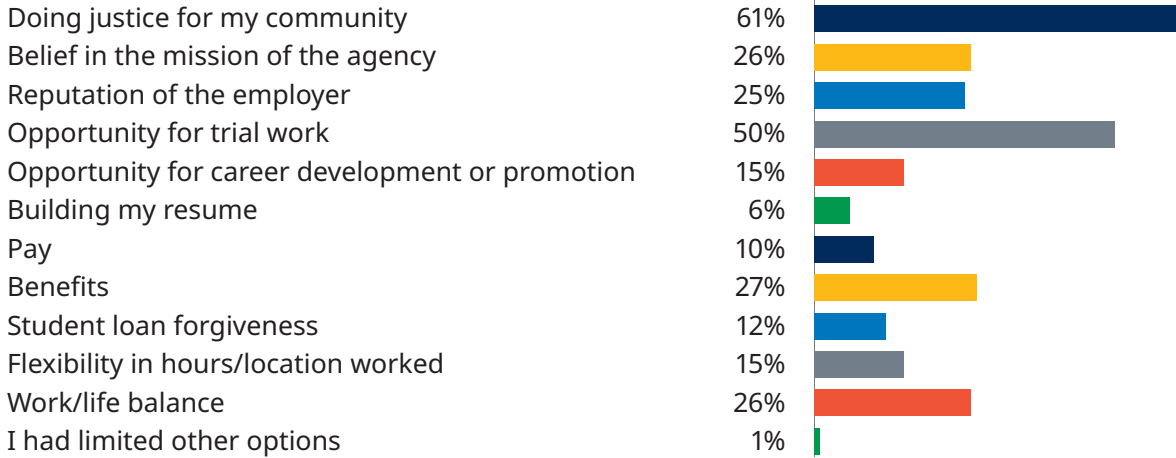

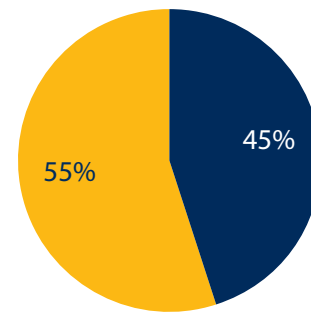

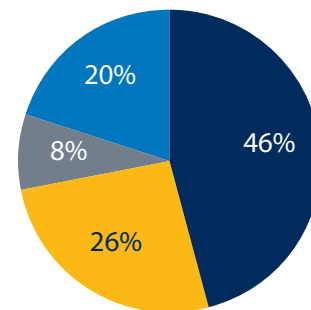

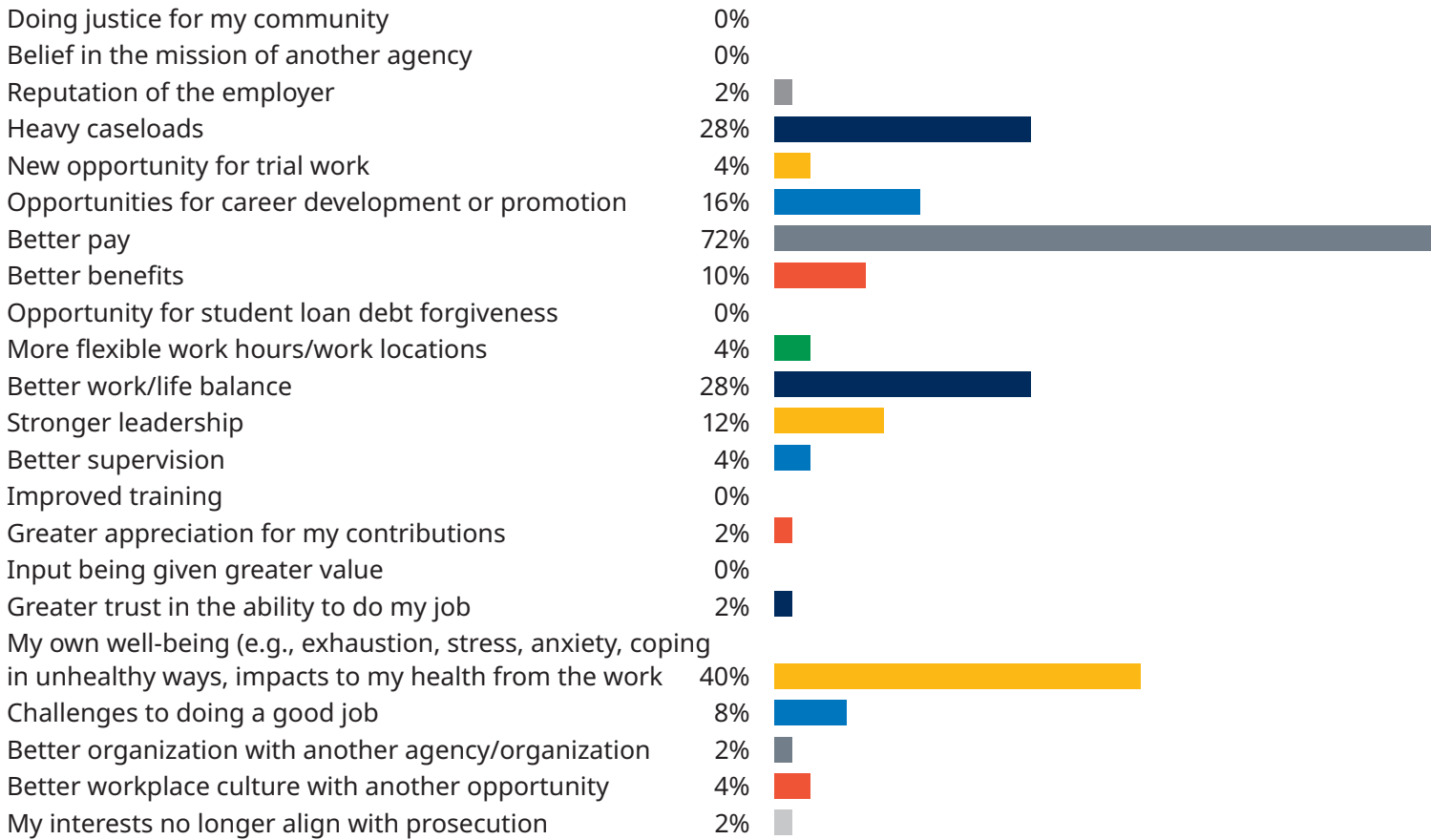

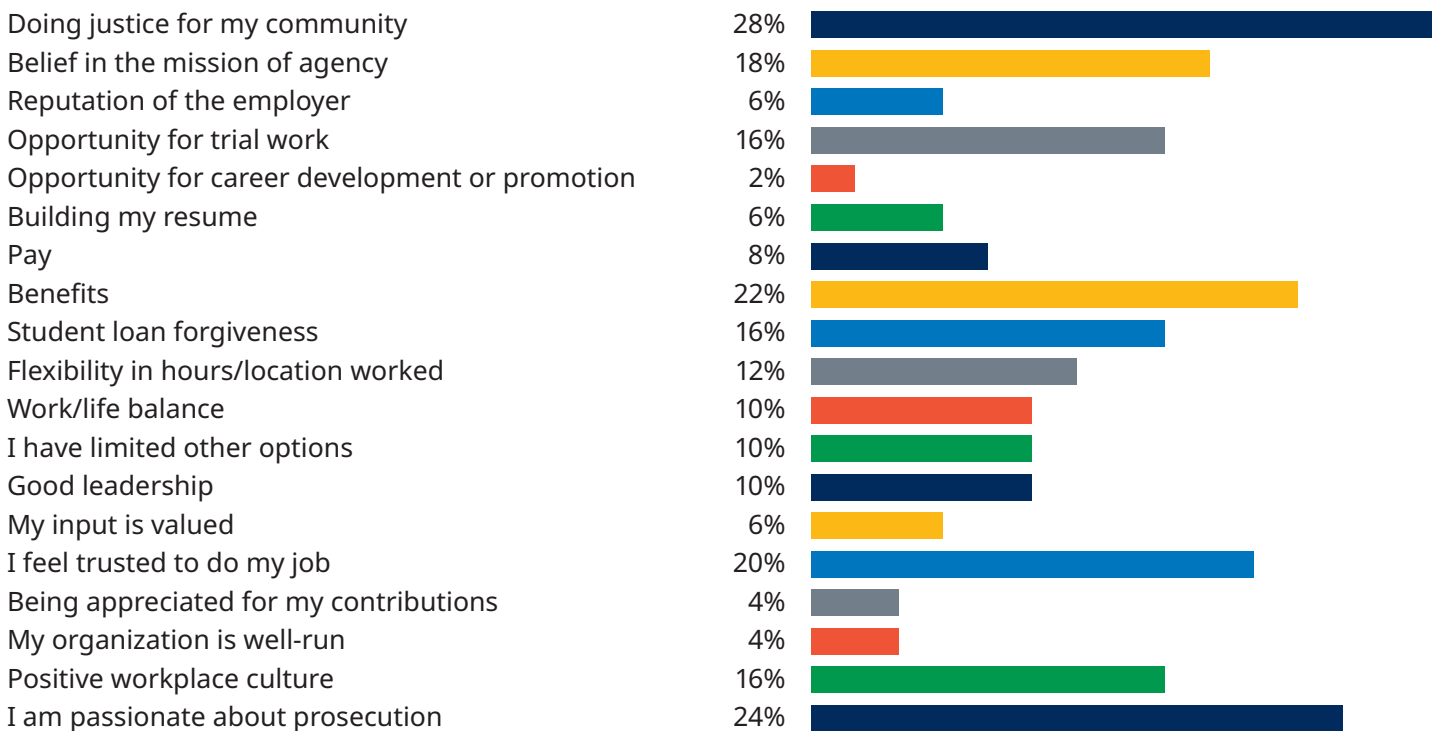
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

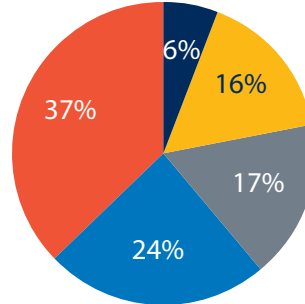

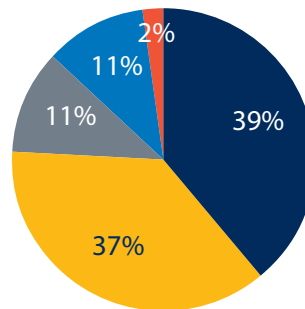

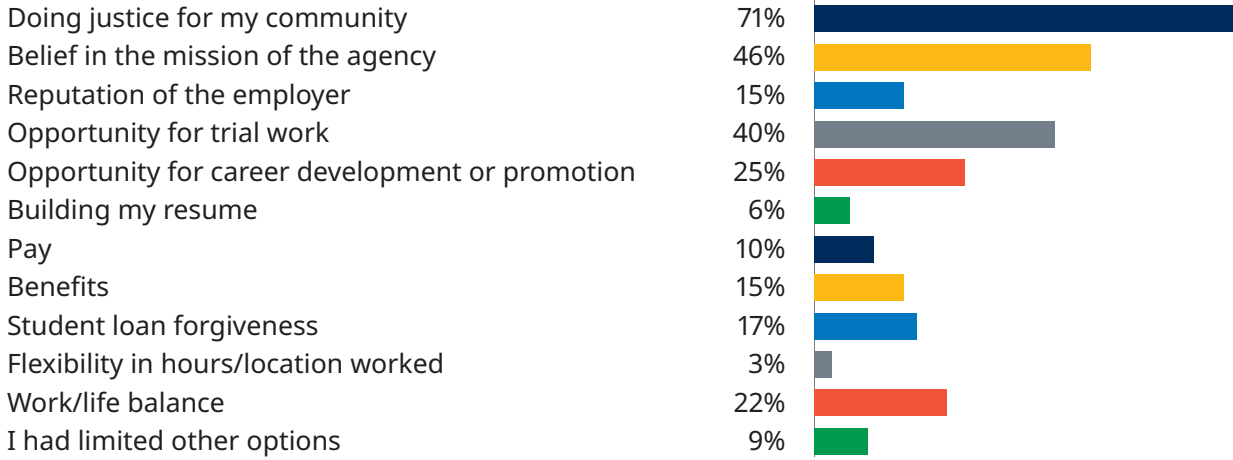

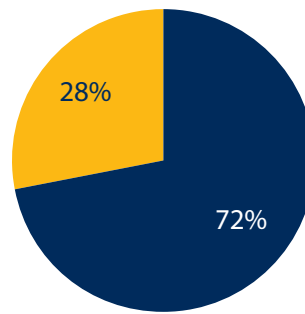

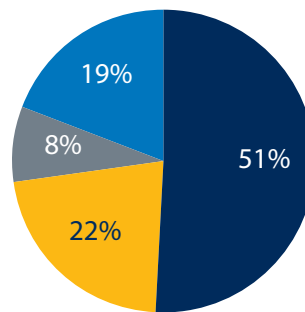

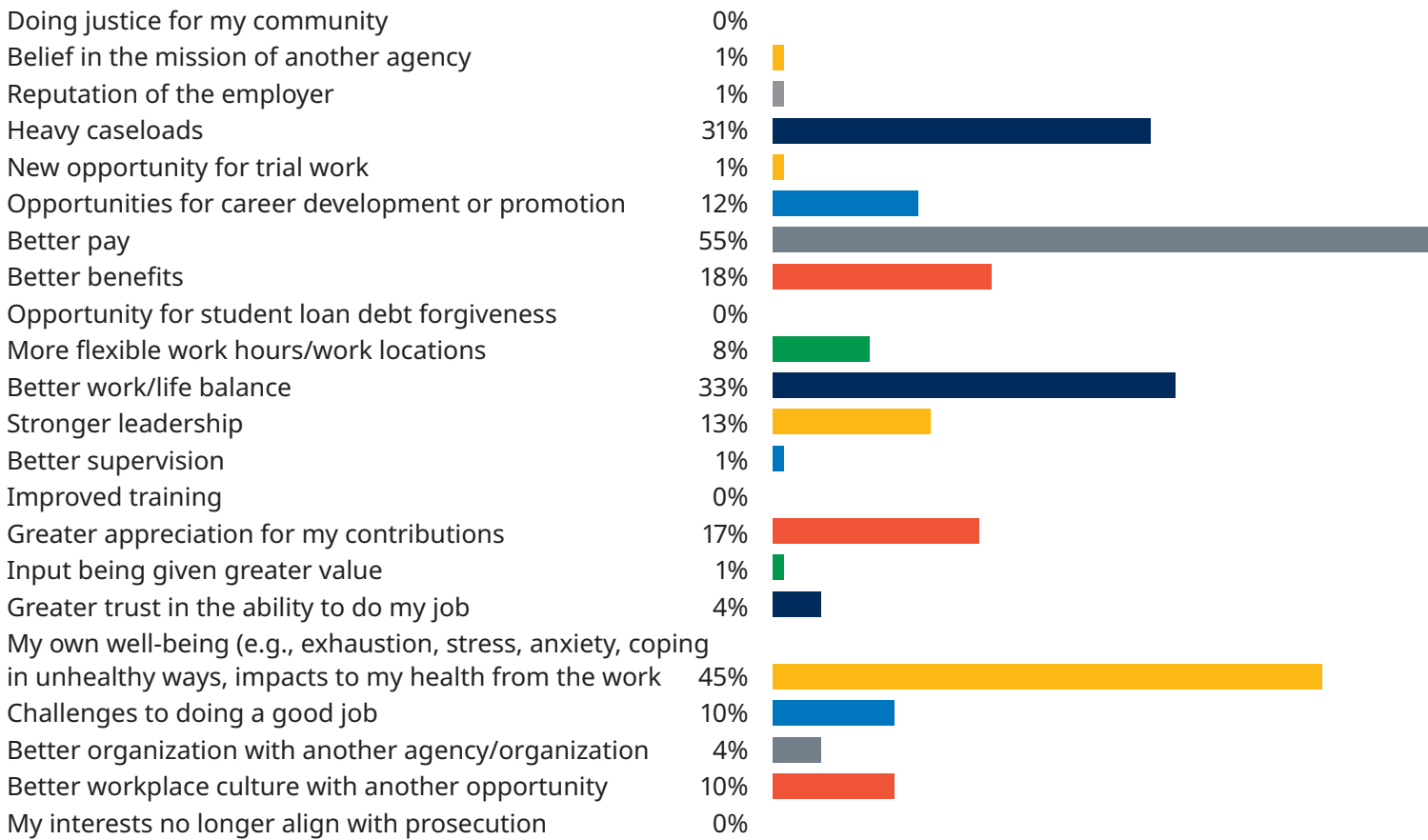

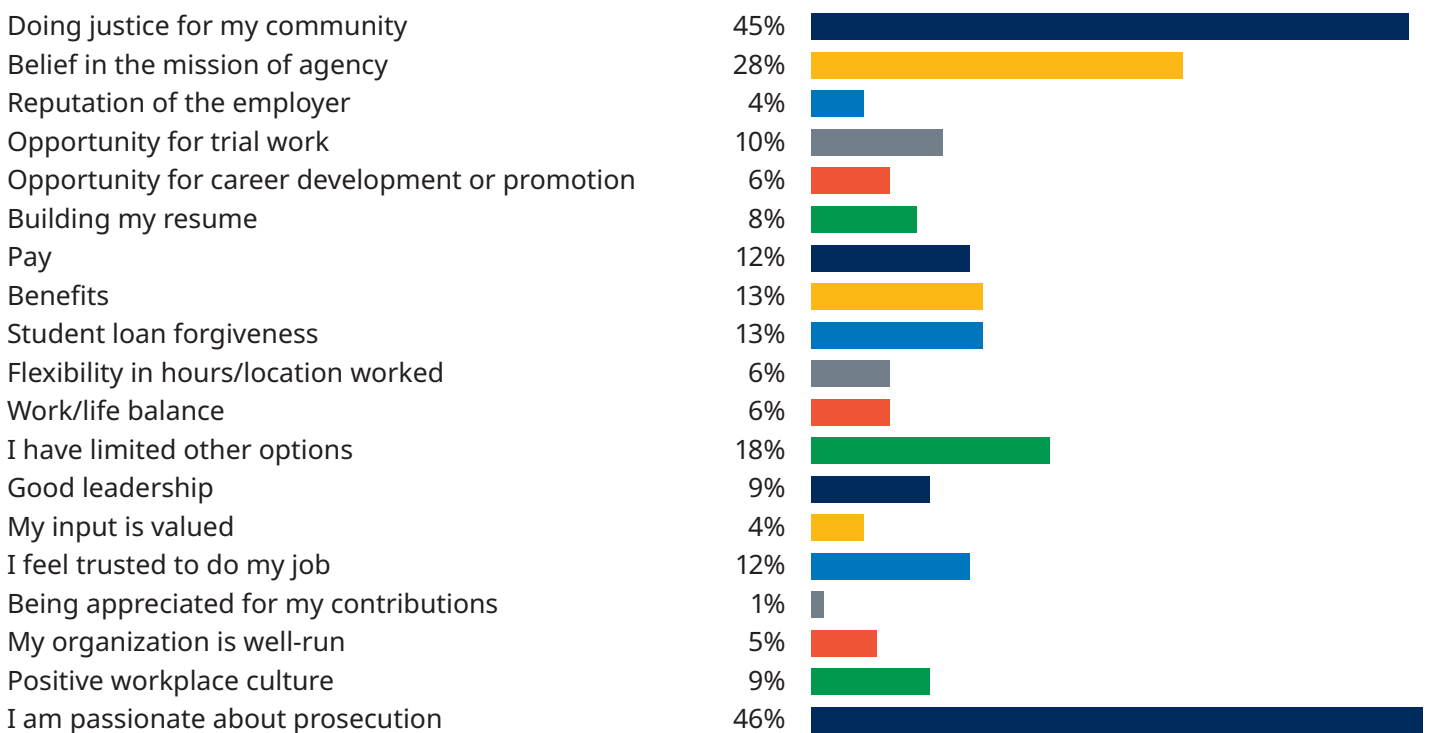
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

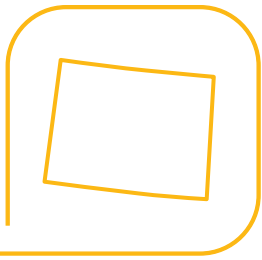

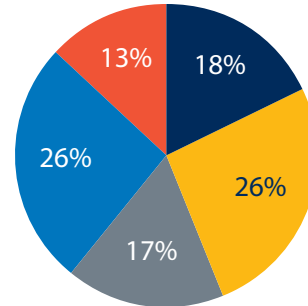

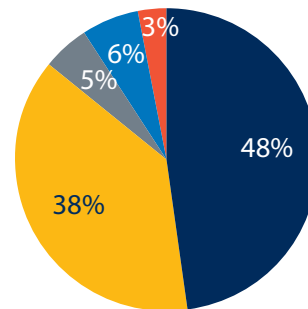

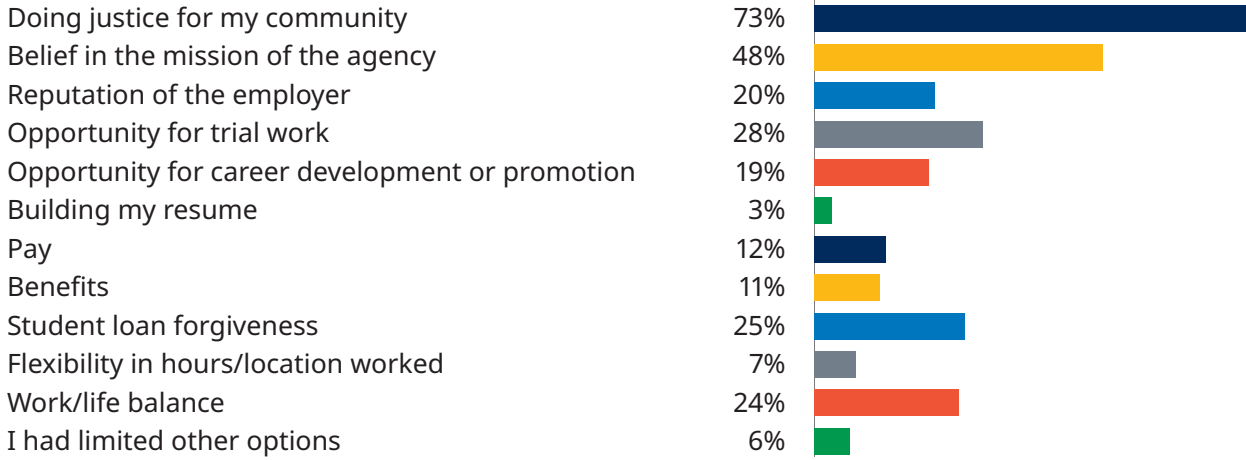

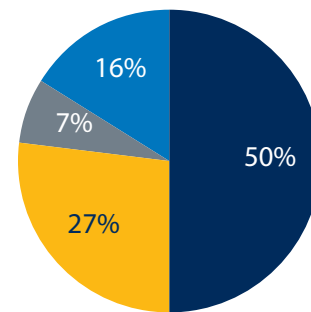

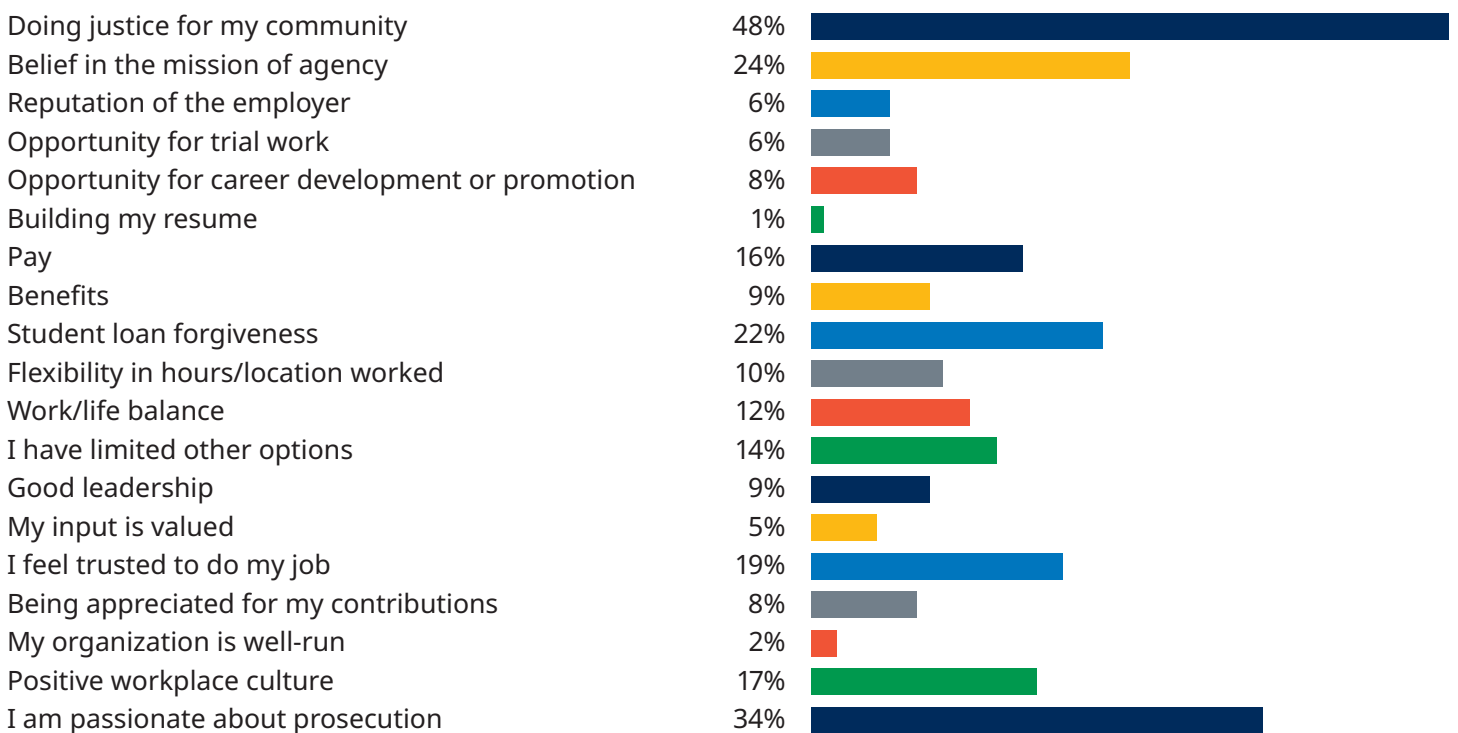

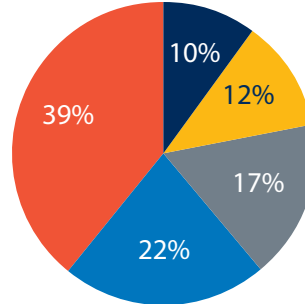

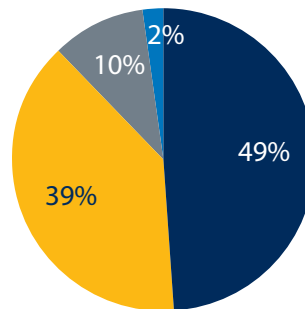

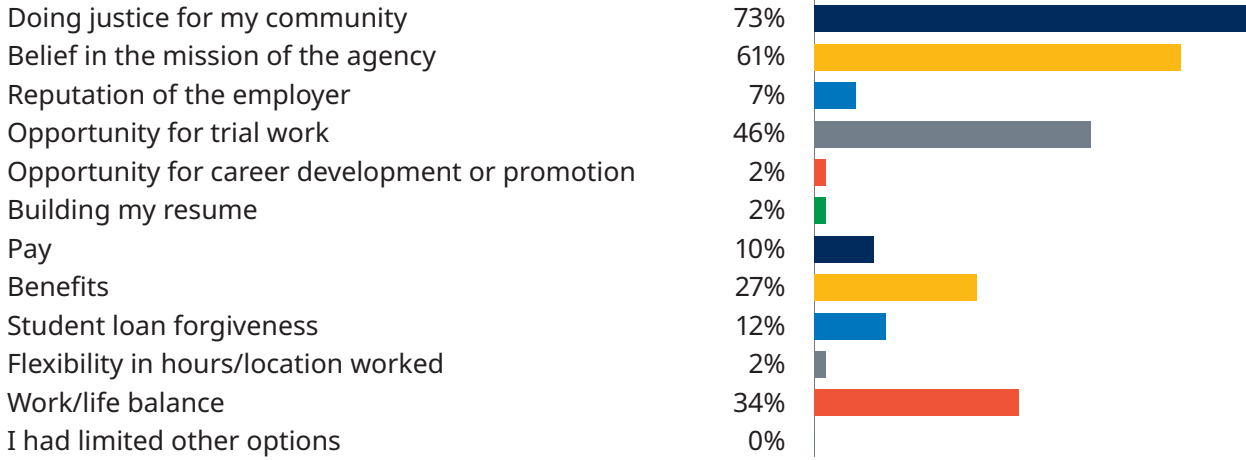

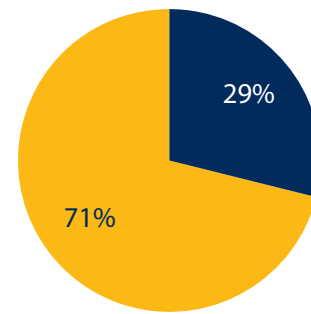

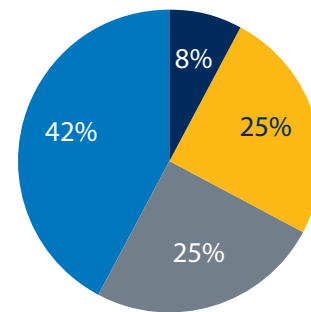

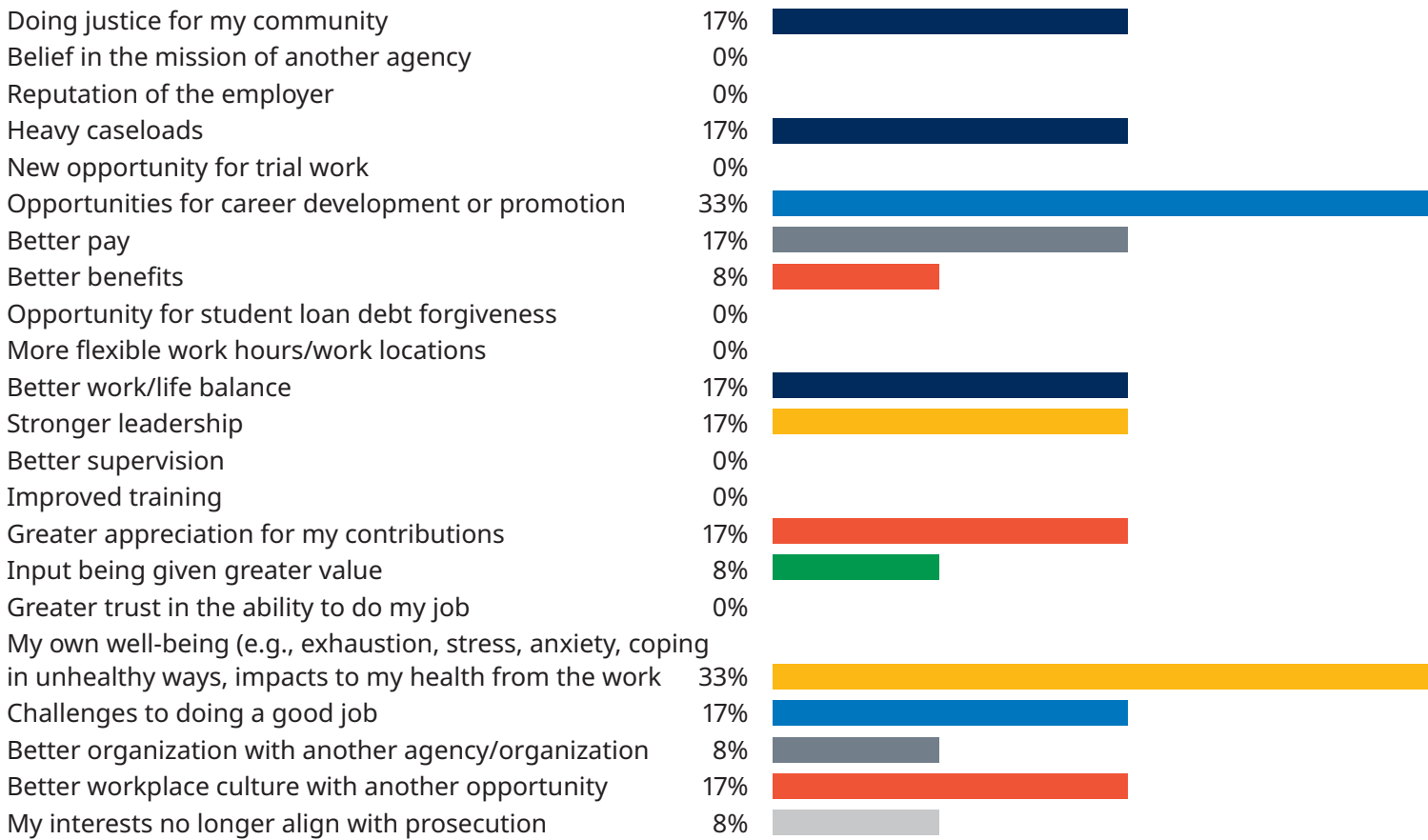

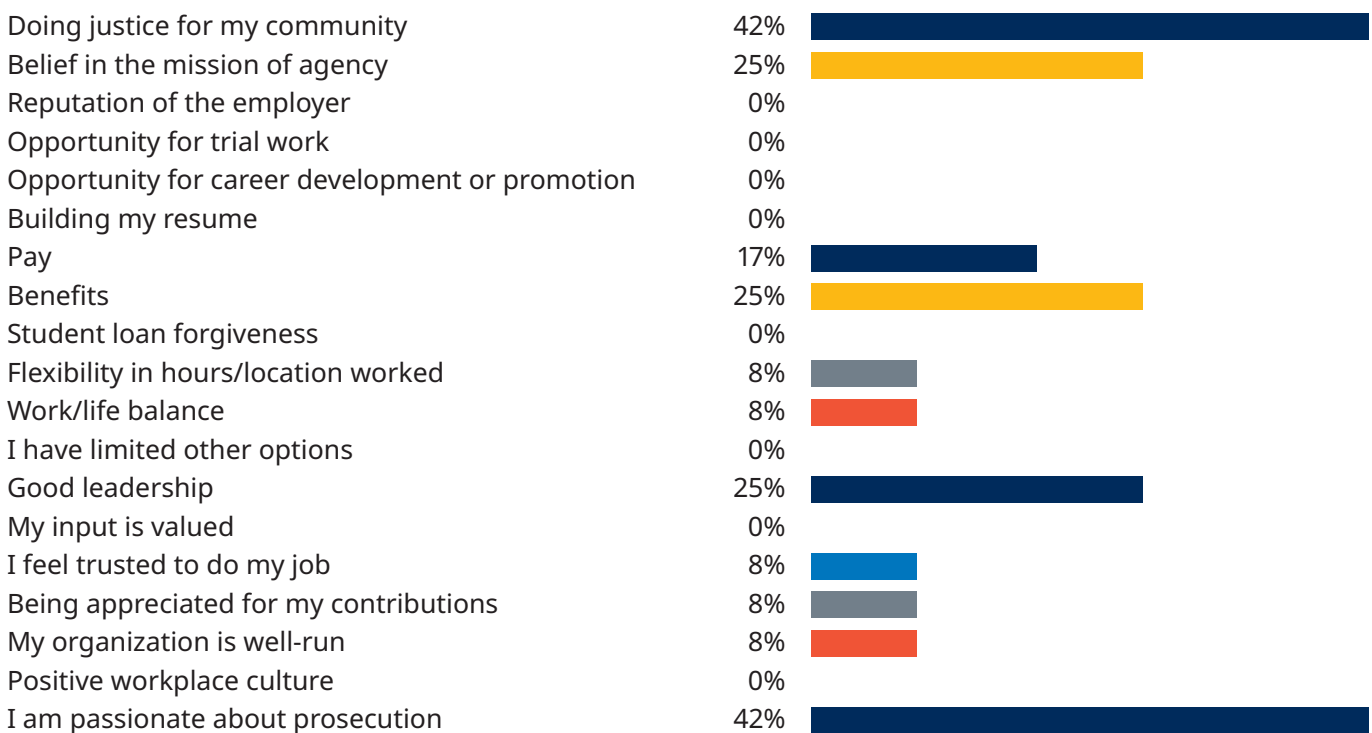
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

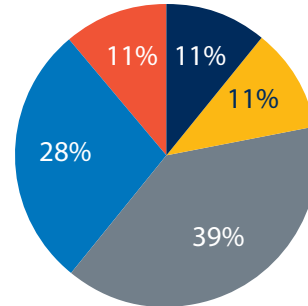

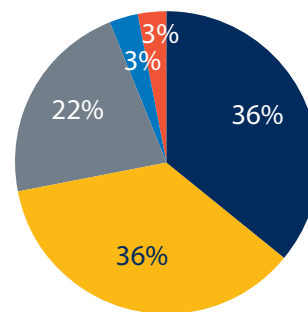

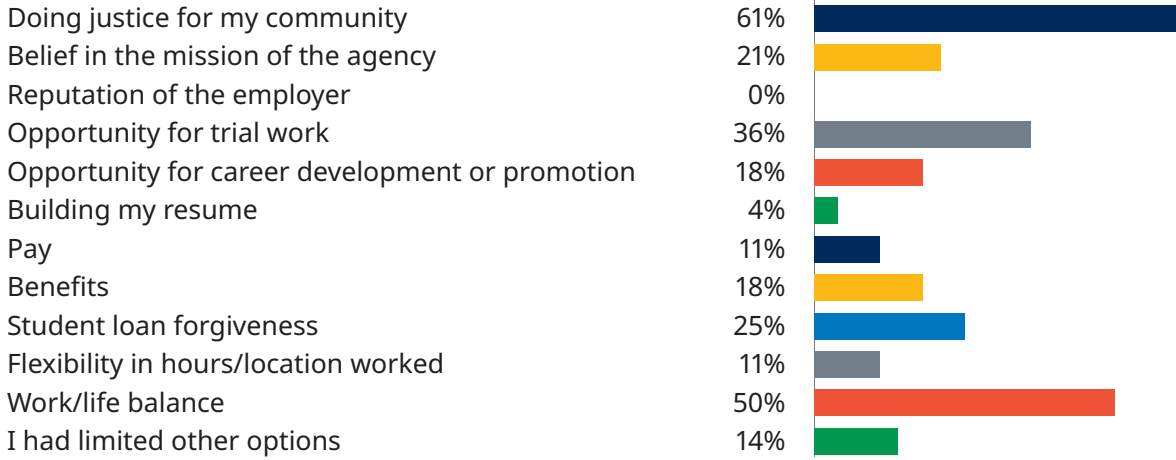

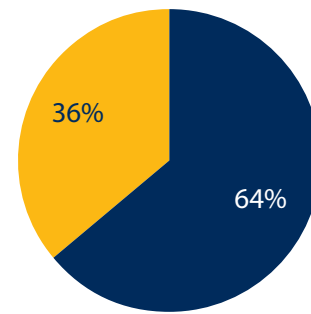

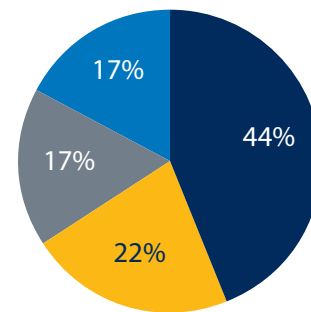

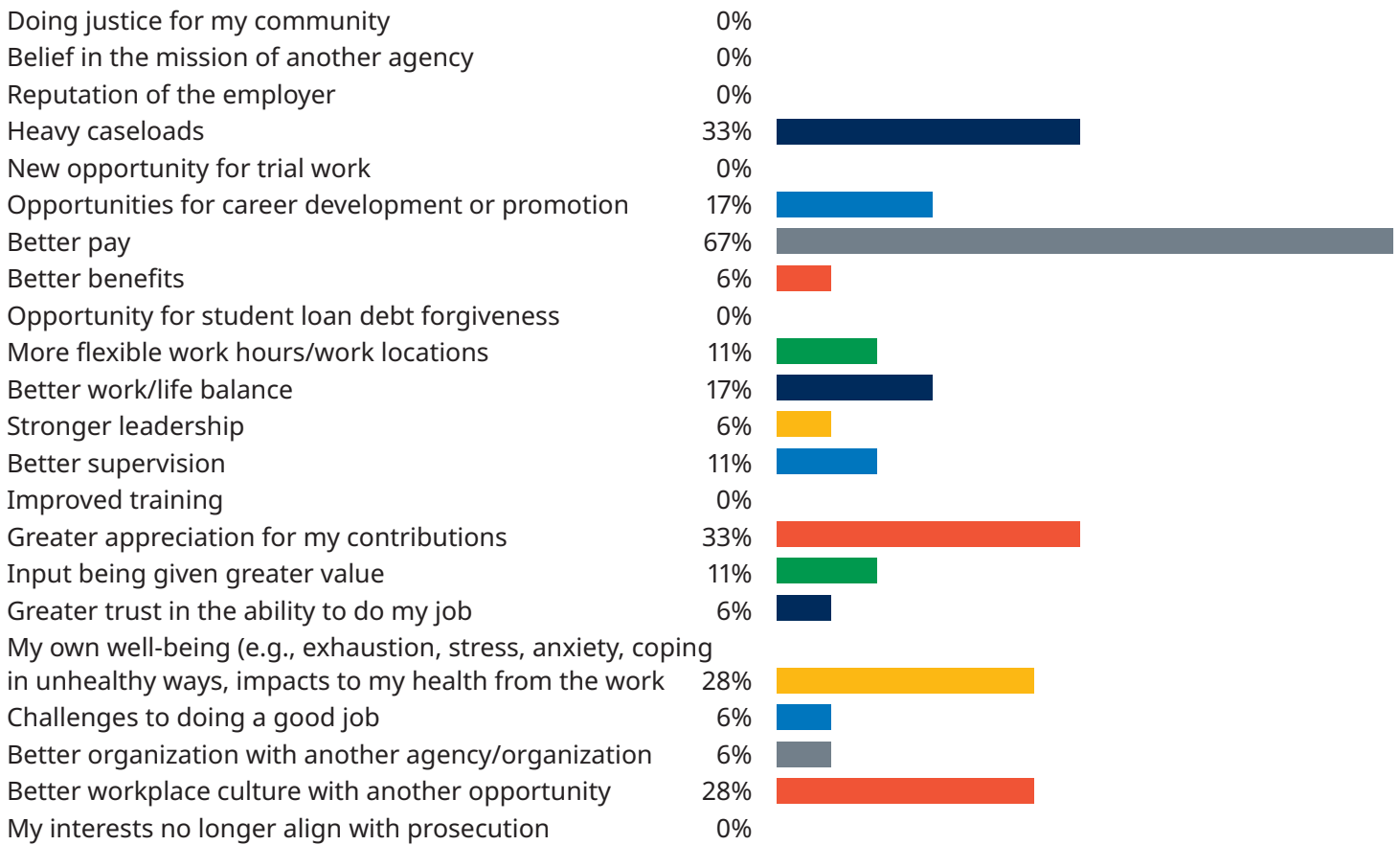

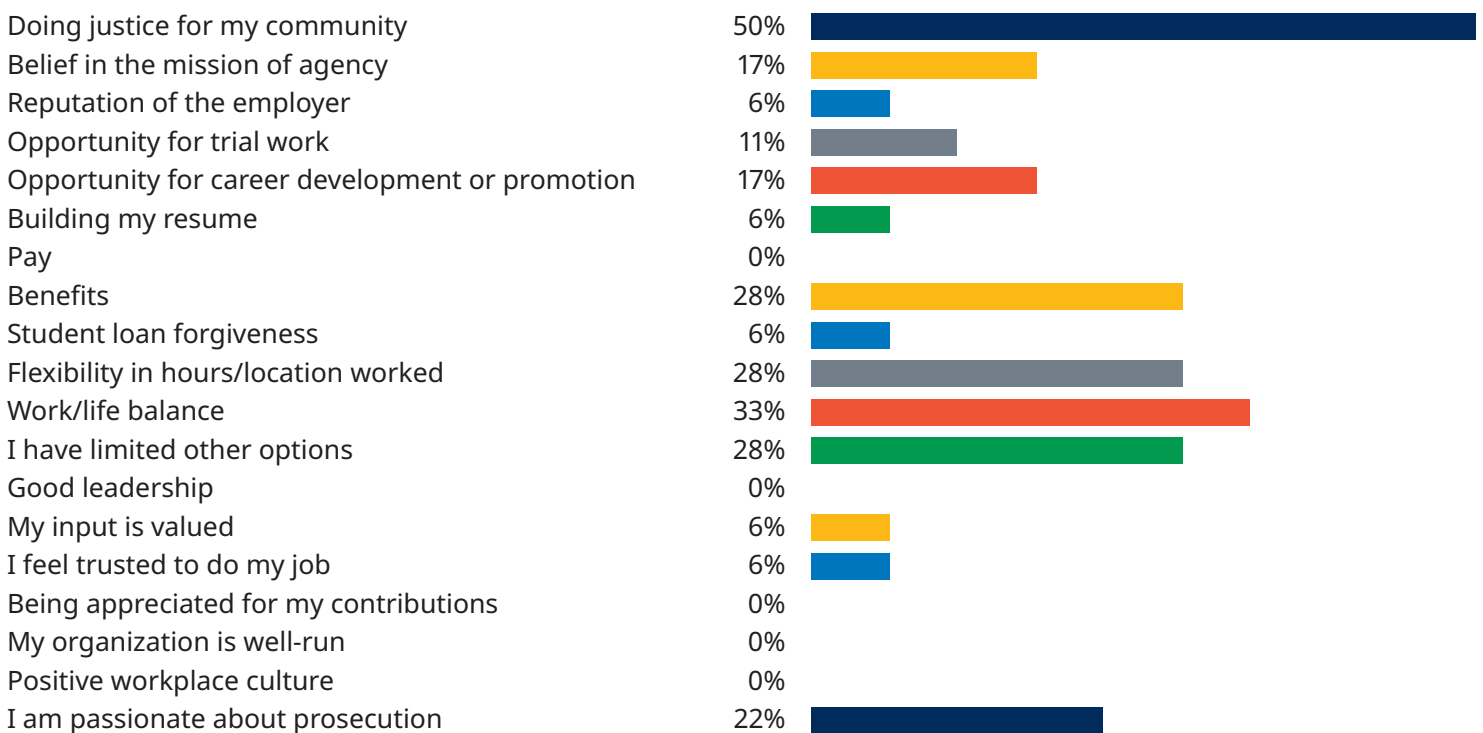
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

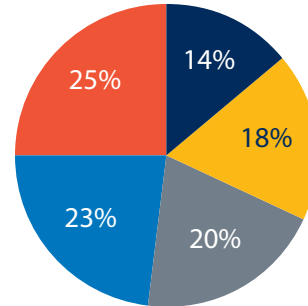

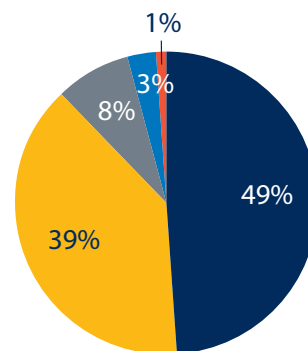

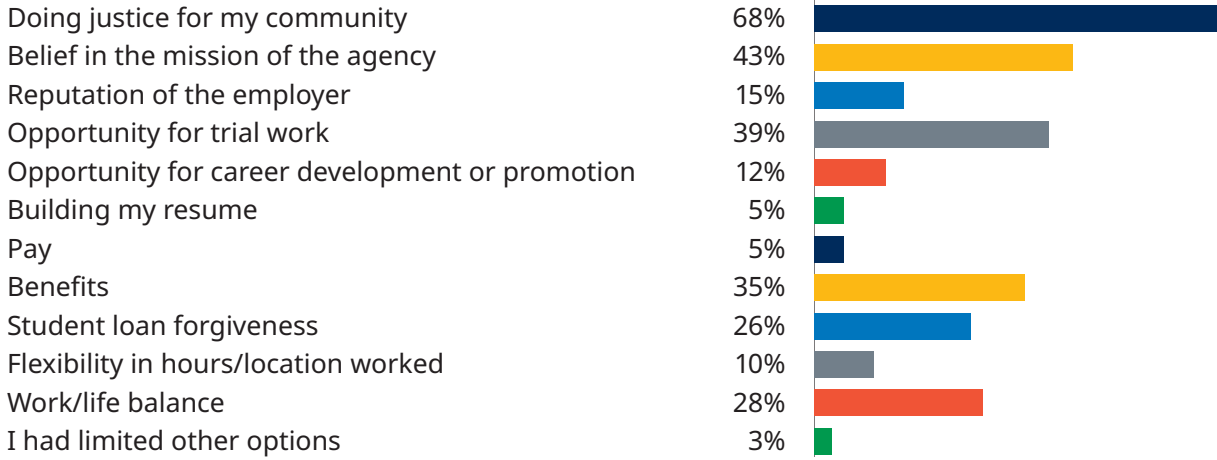

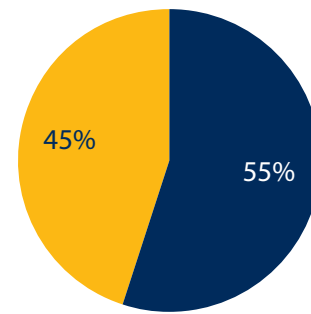

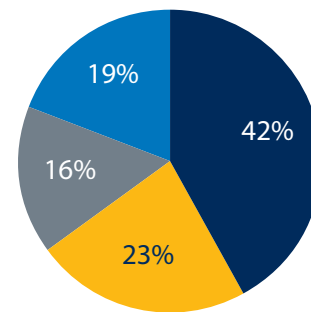

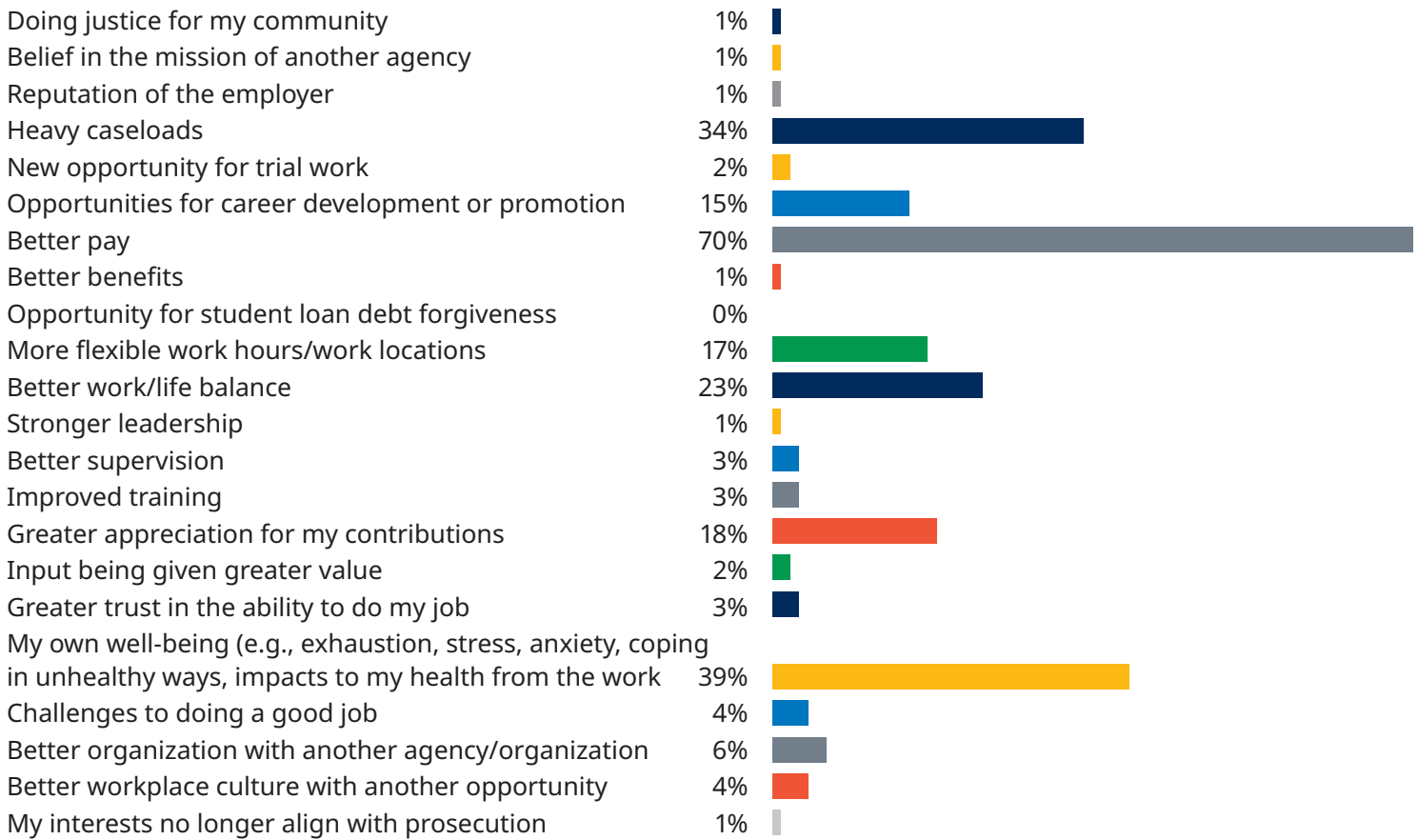

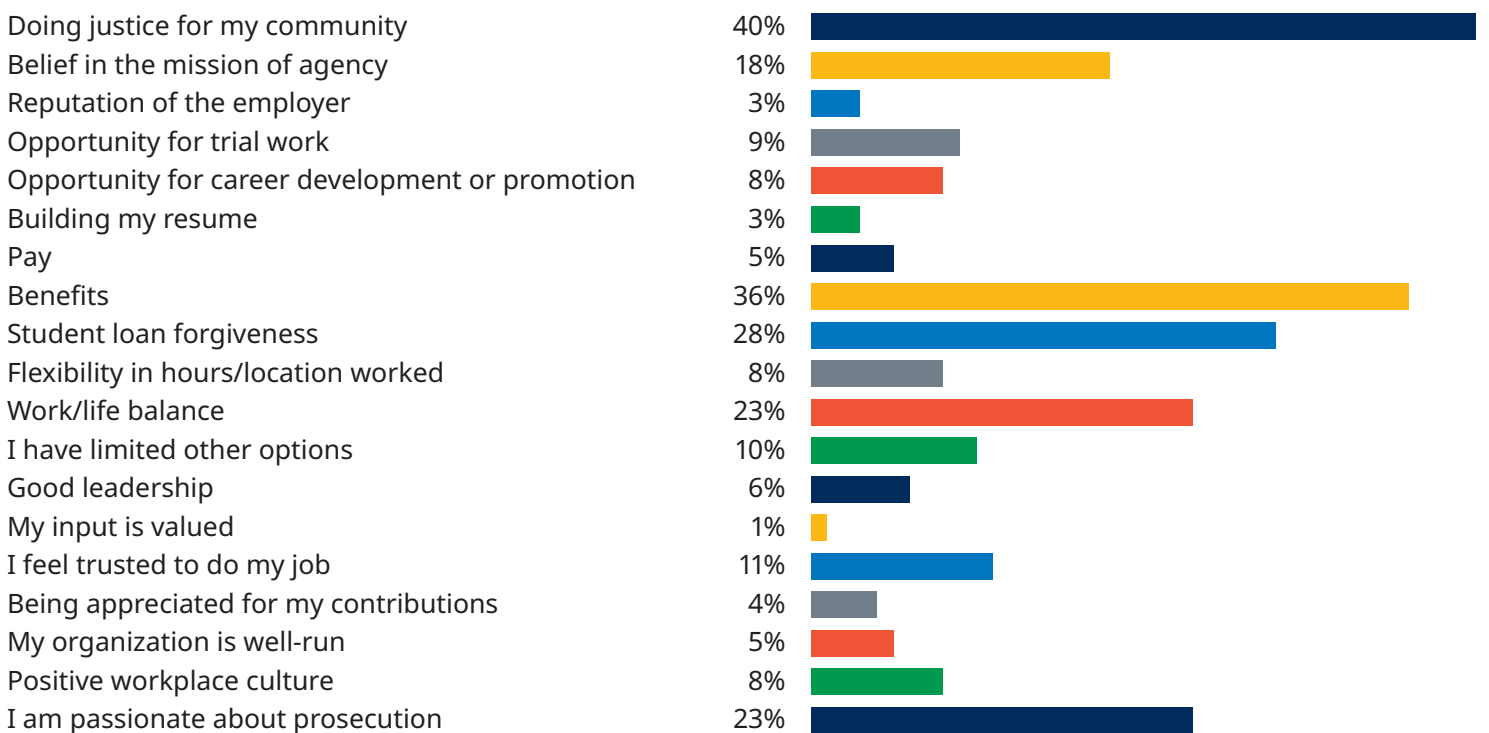
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

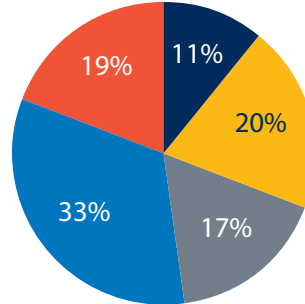

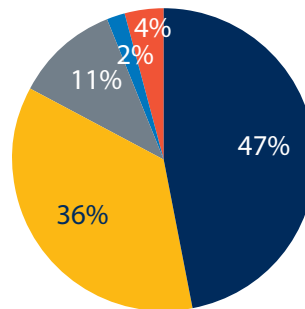

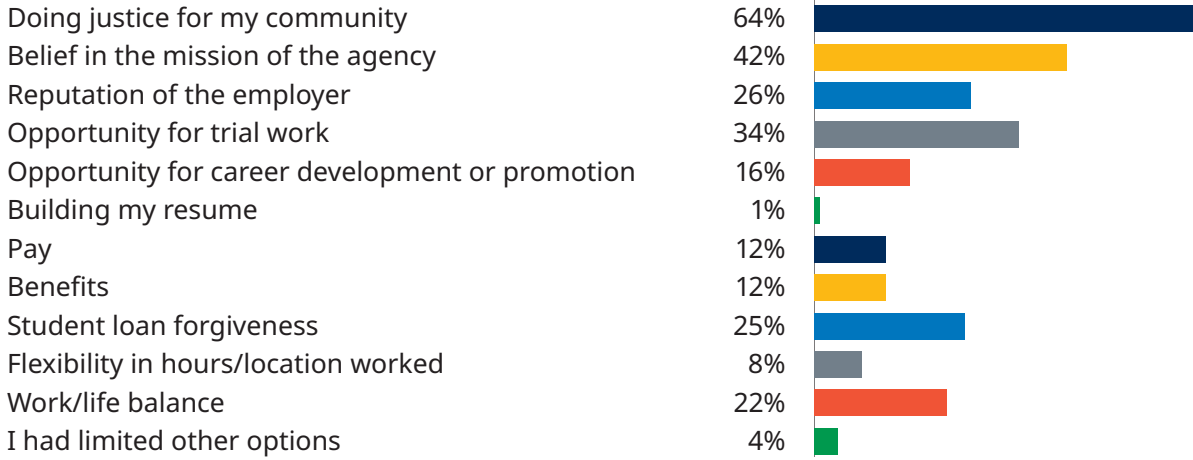

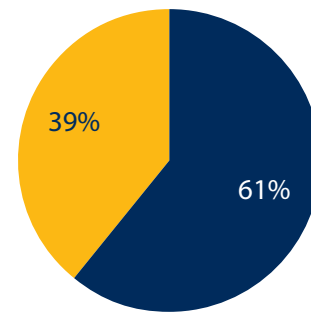

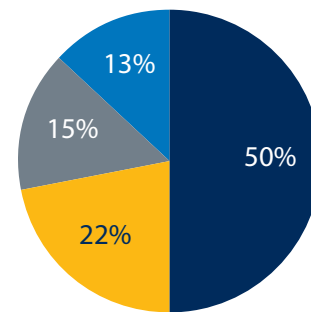

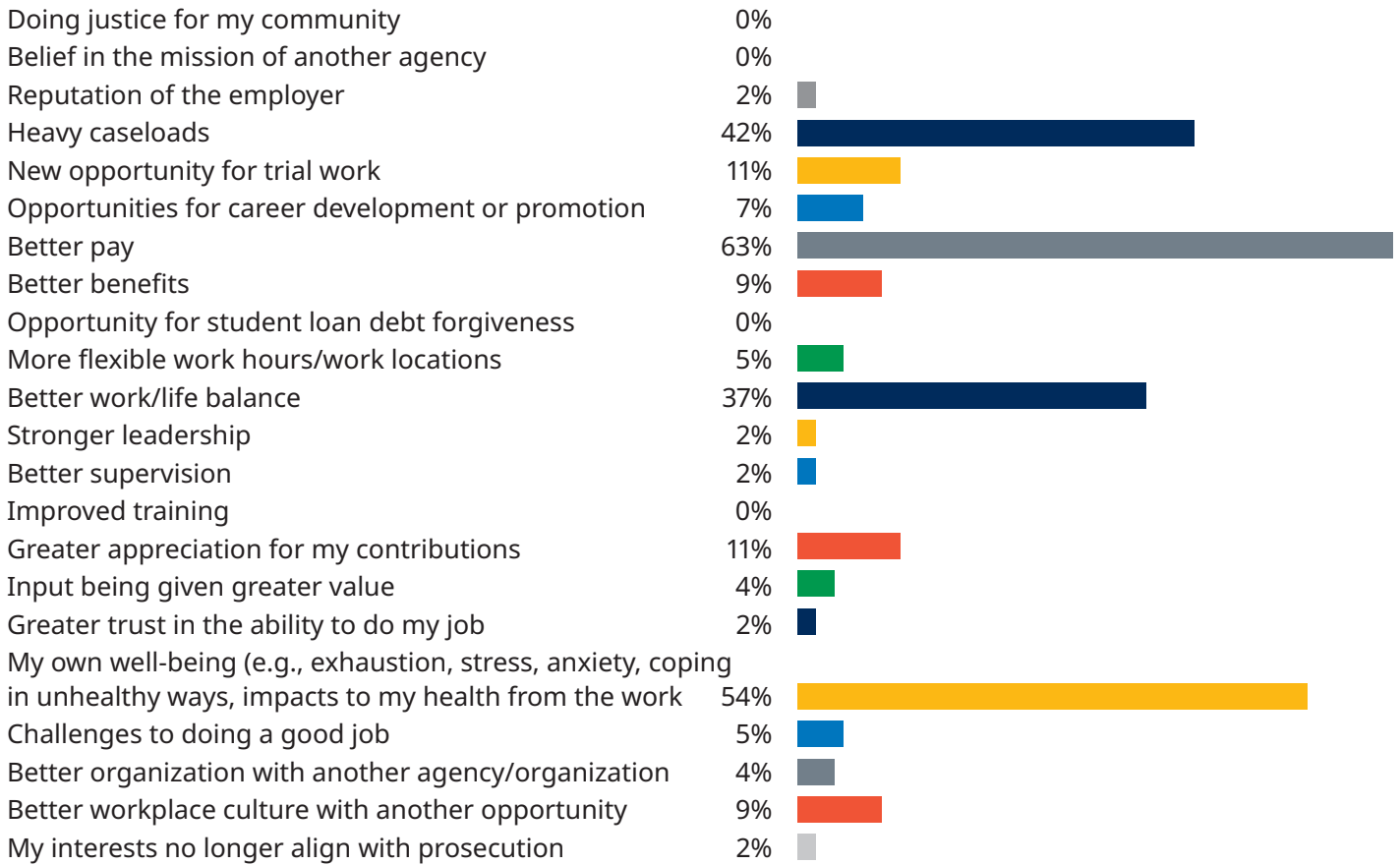

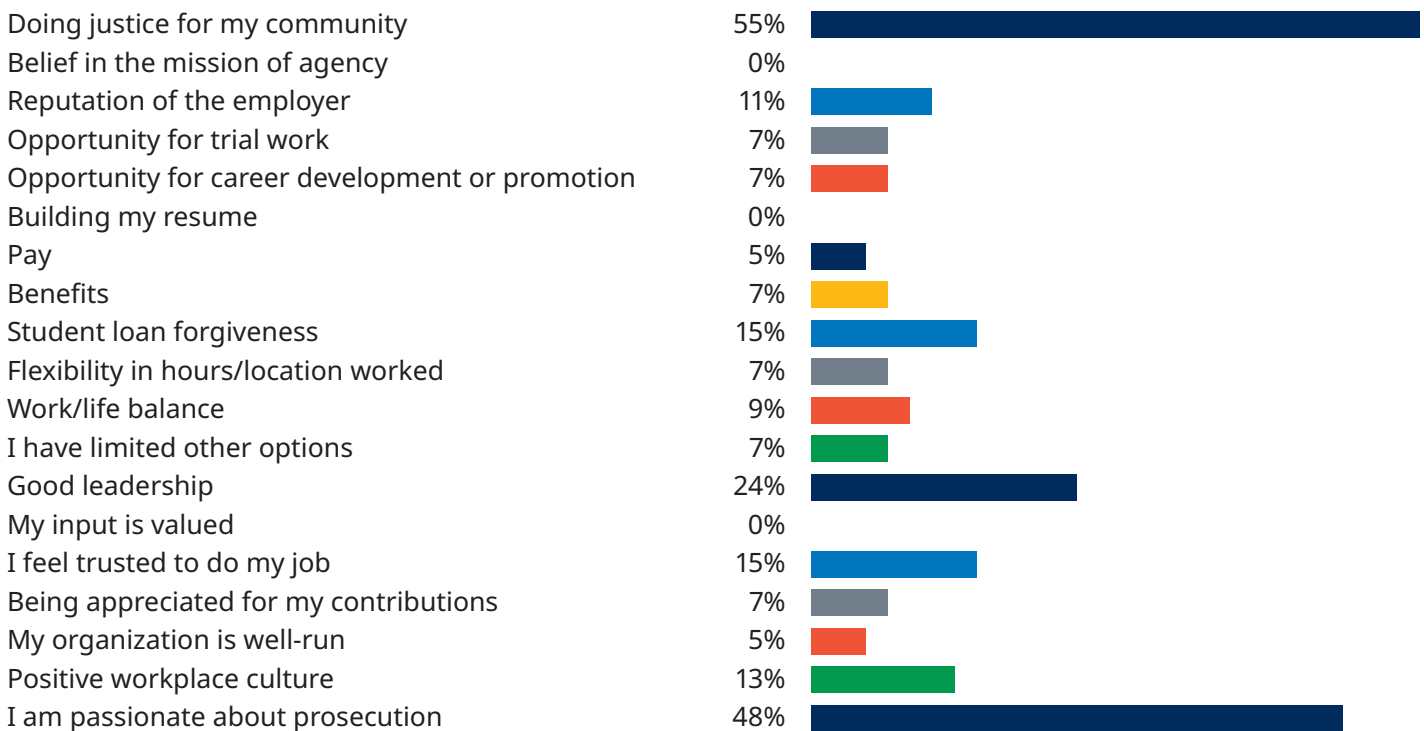
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

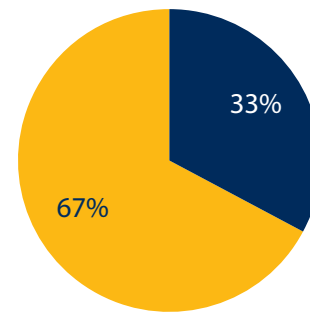

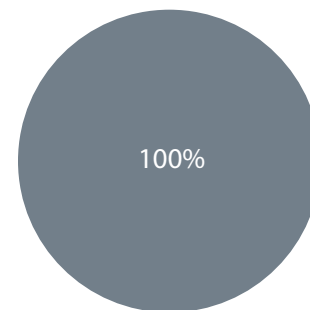

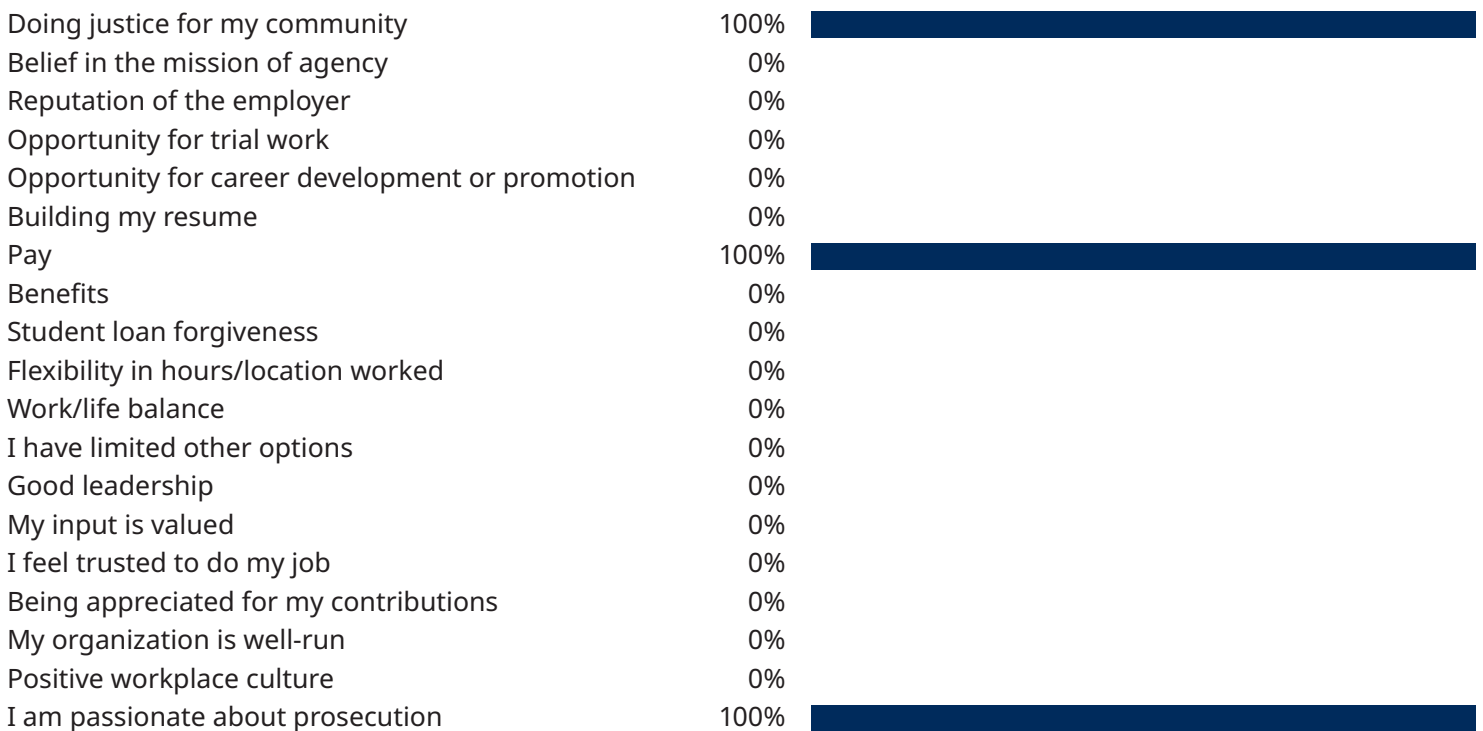

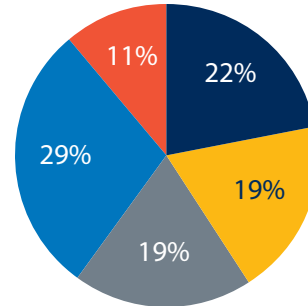

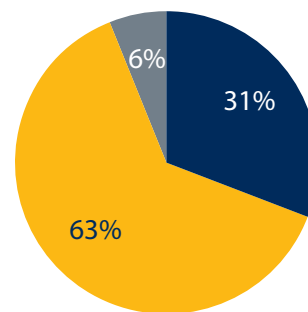

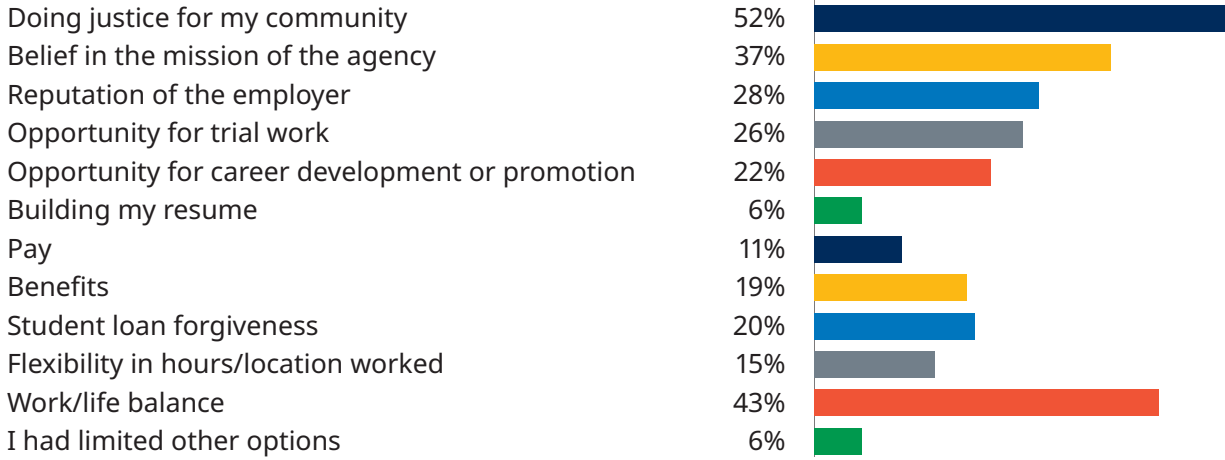

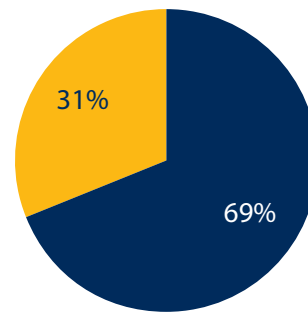

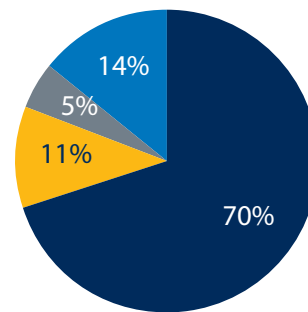

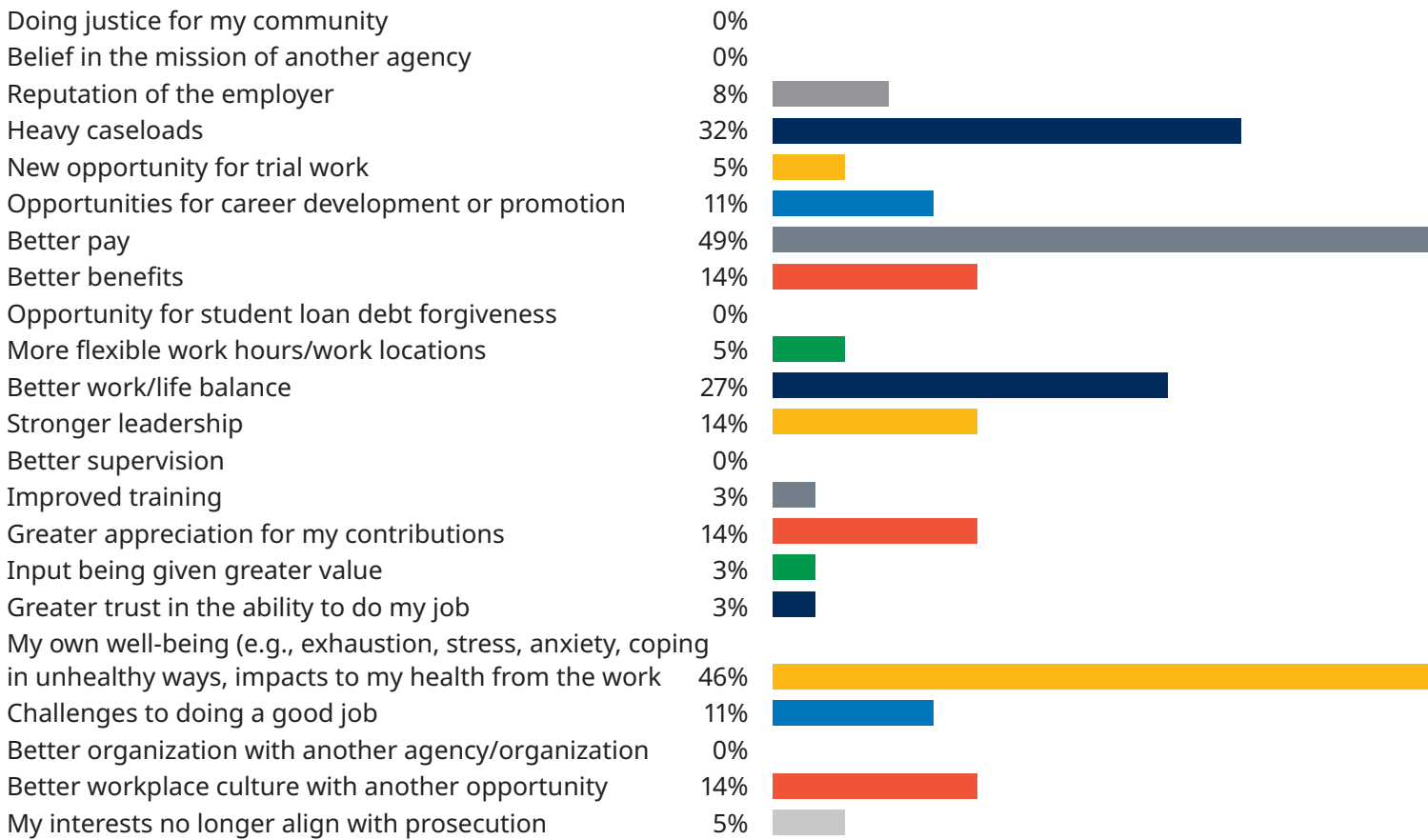

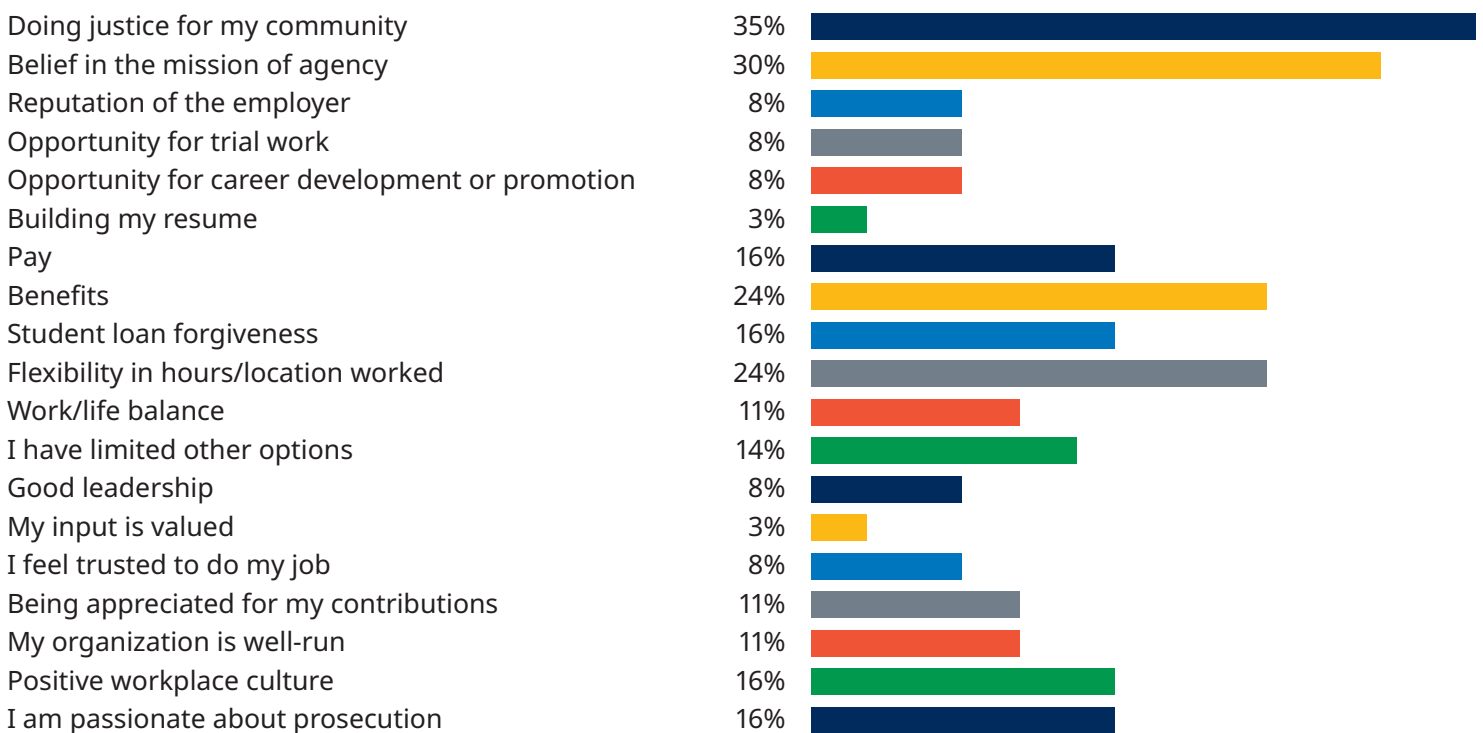

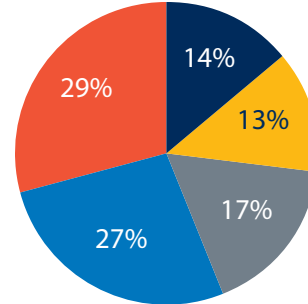

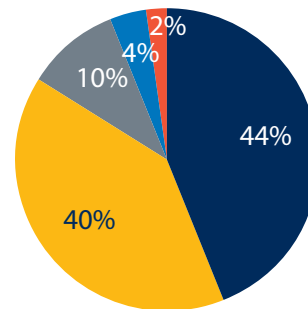

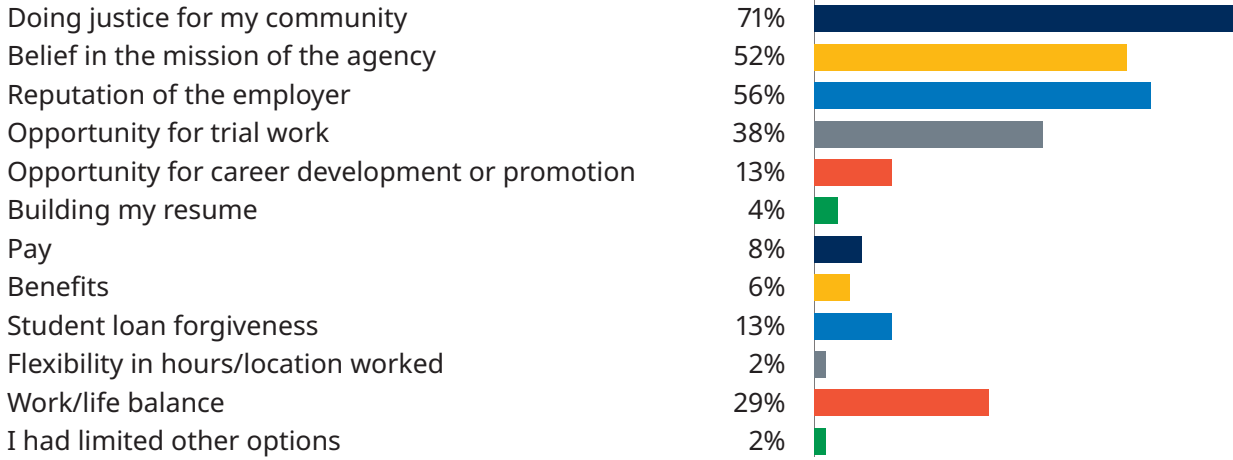

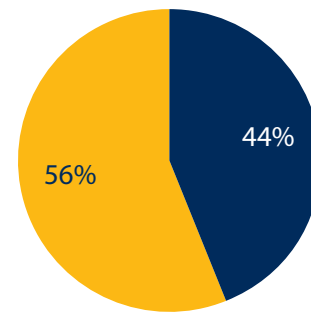

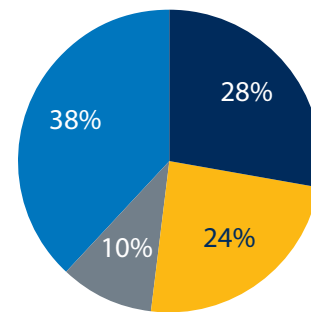

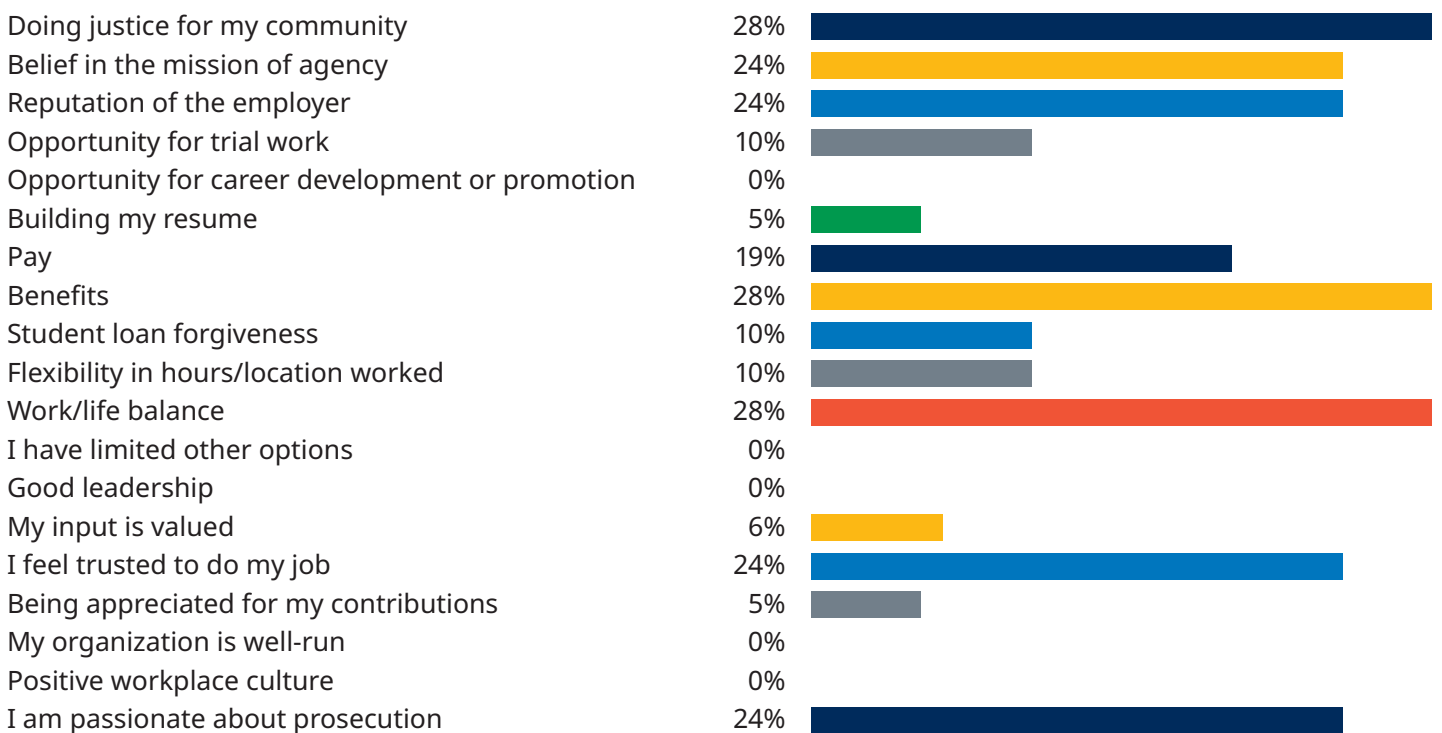

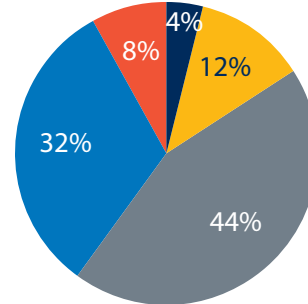

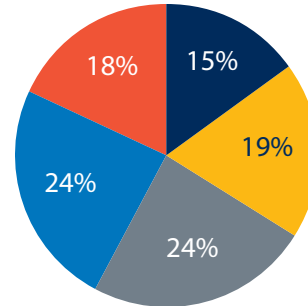

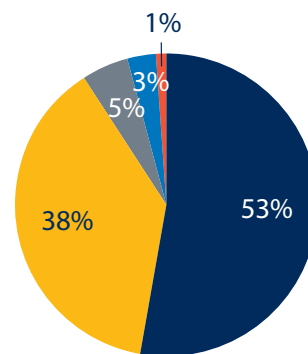

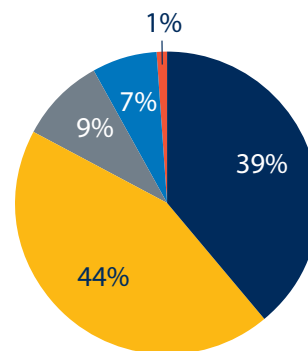

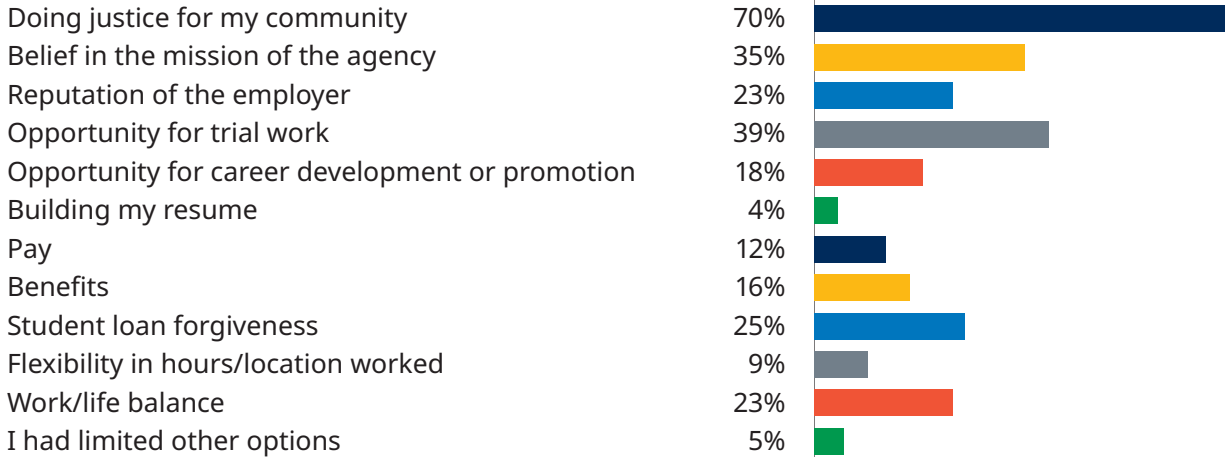

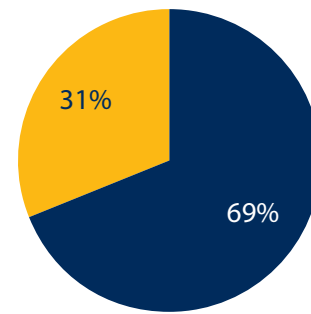
Q4. What were the most important factors in deciding to work for your current employer?

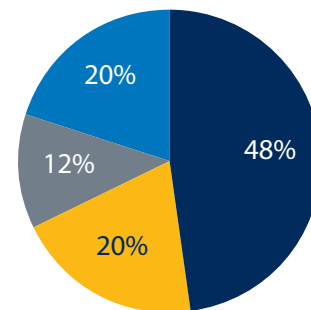

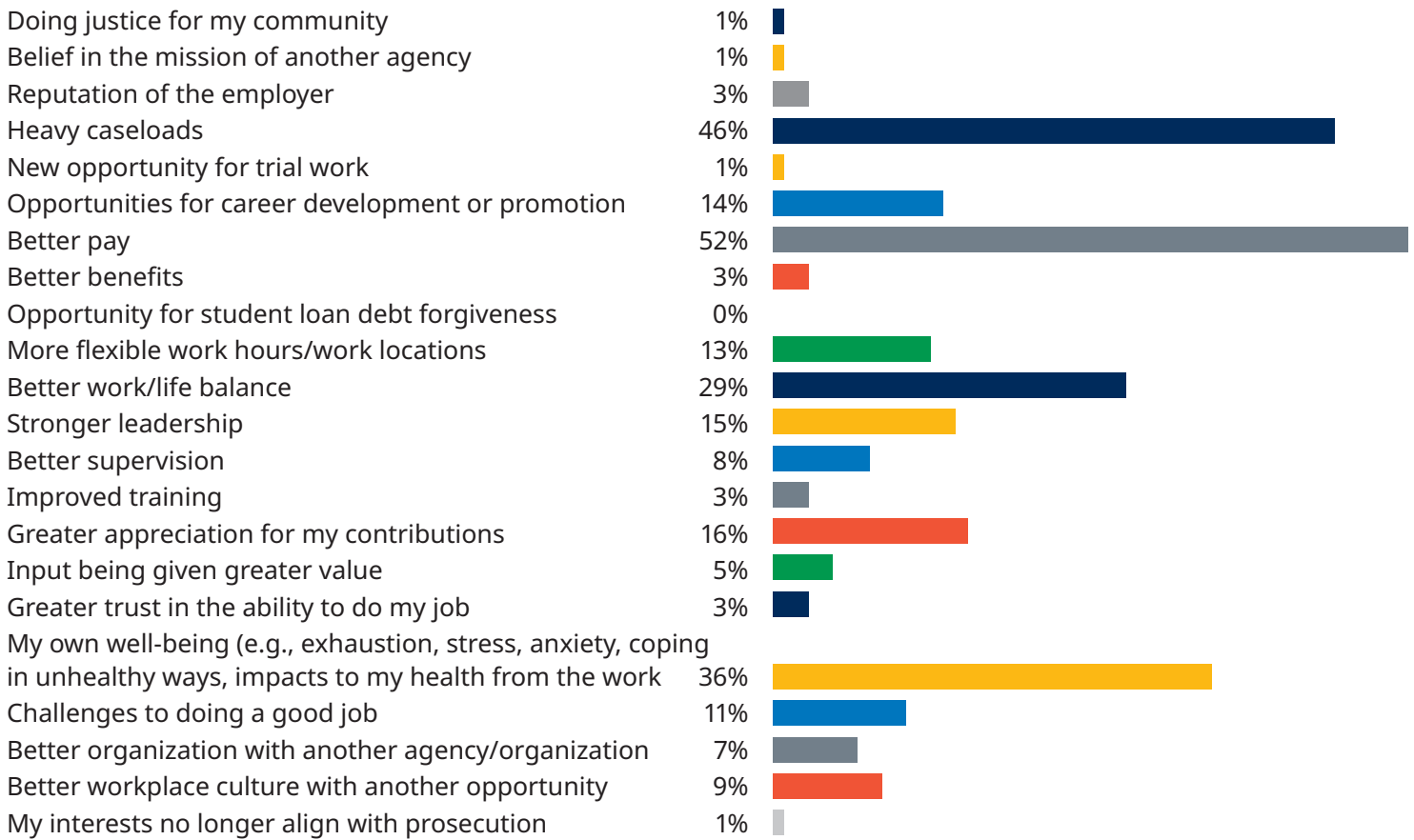

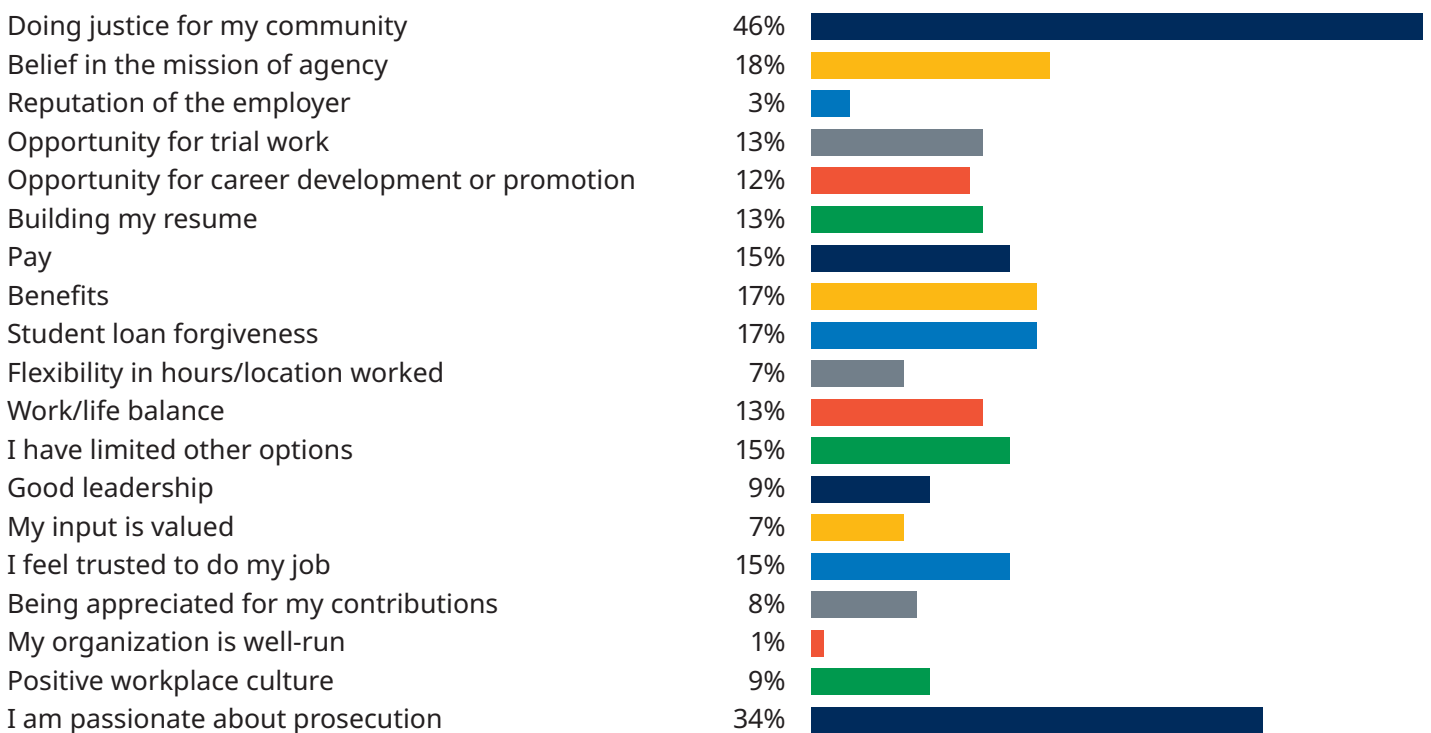
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

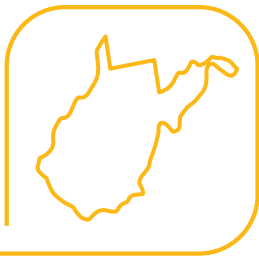

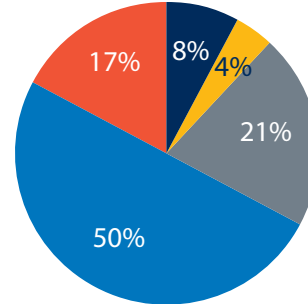

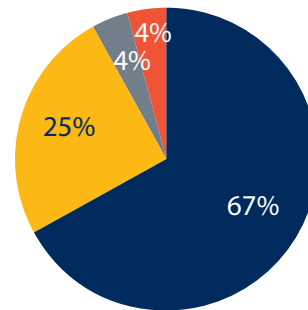

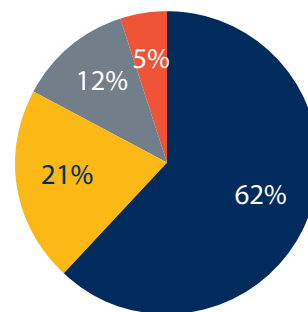

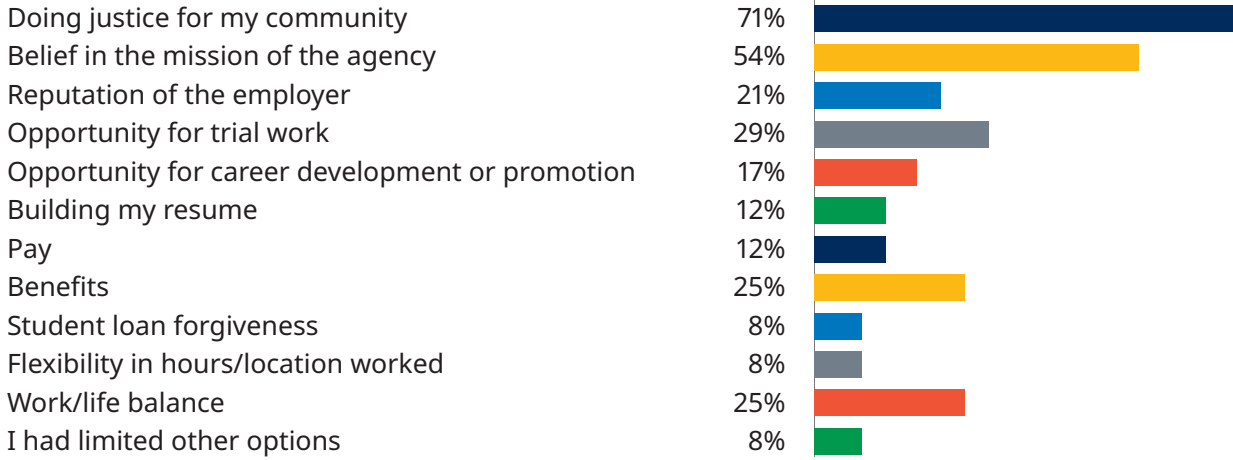

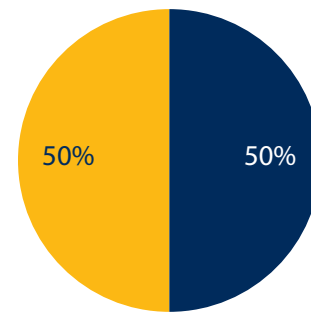

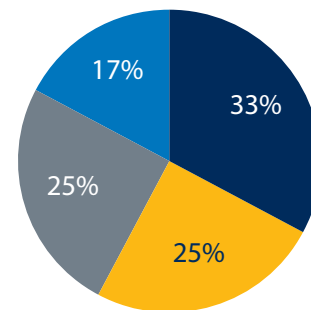

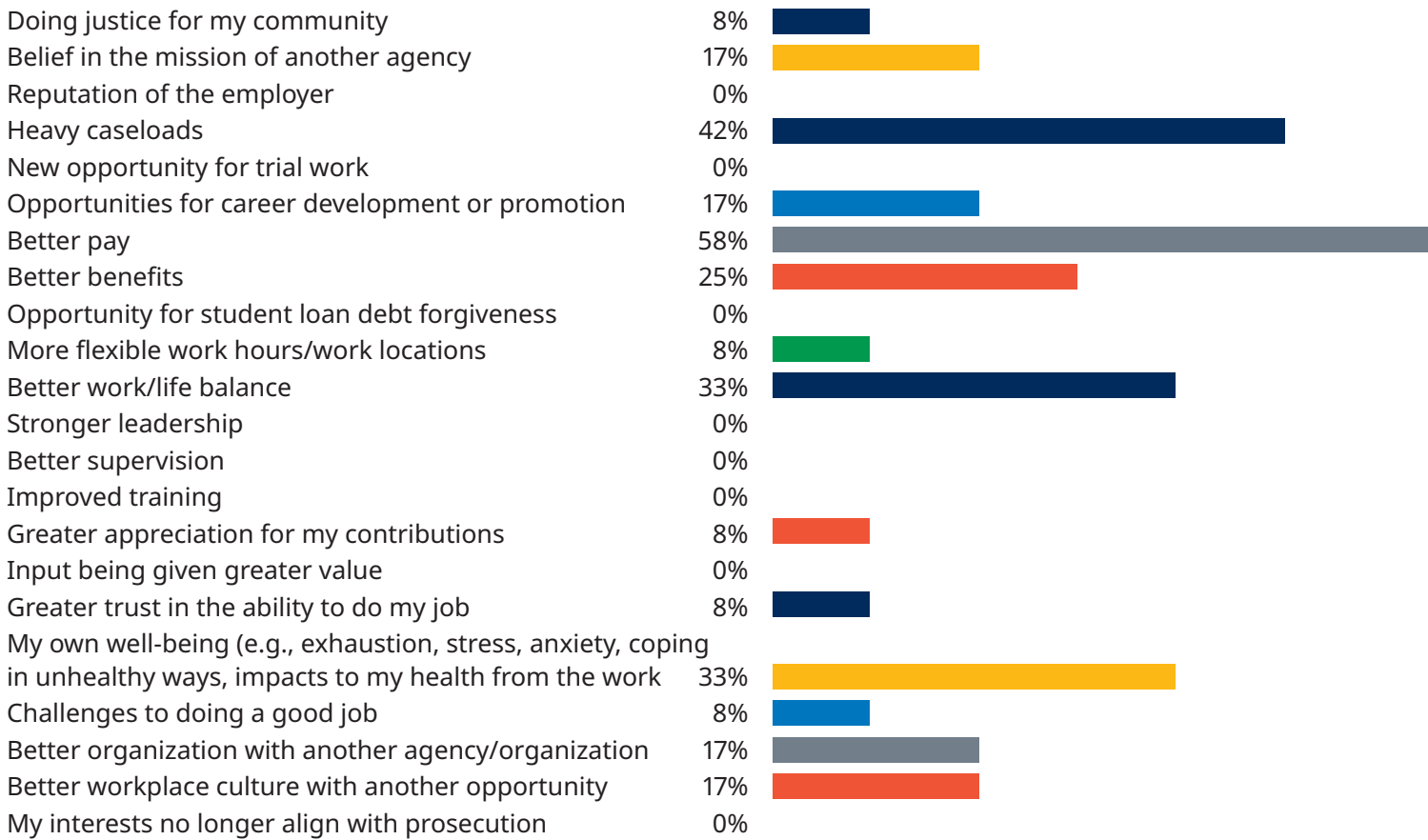

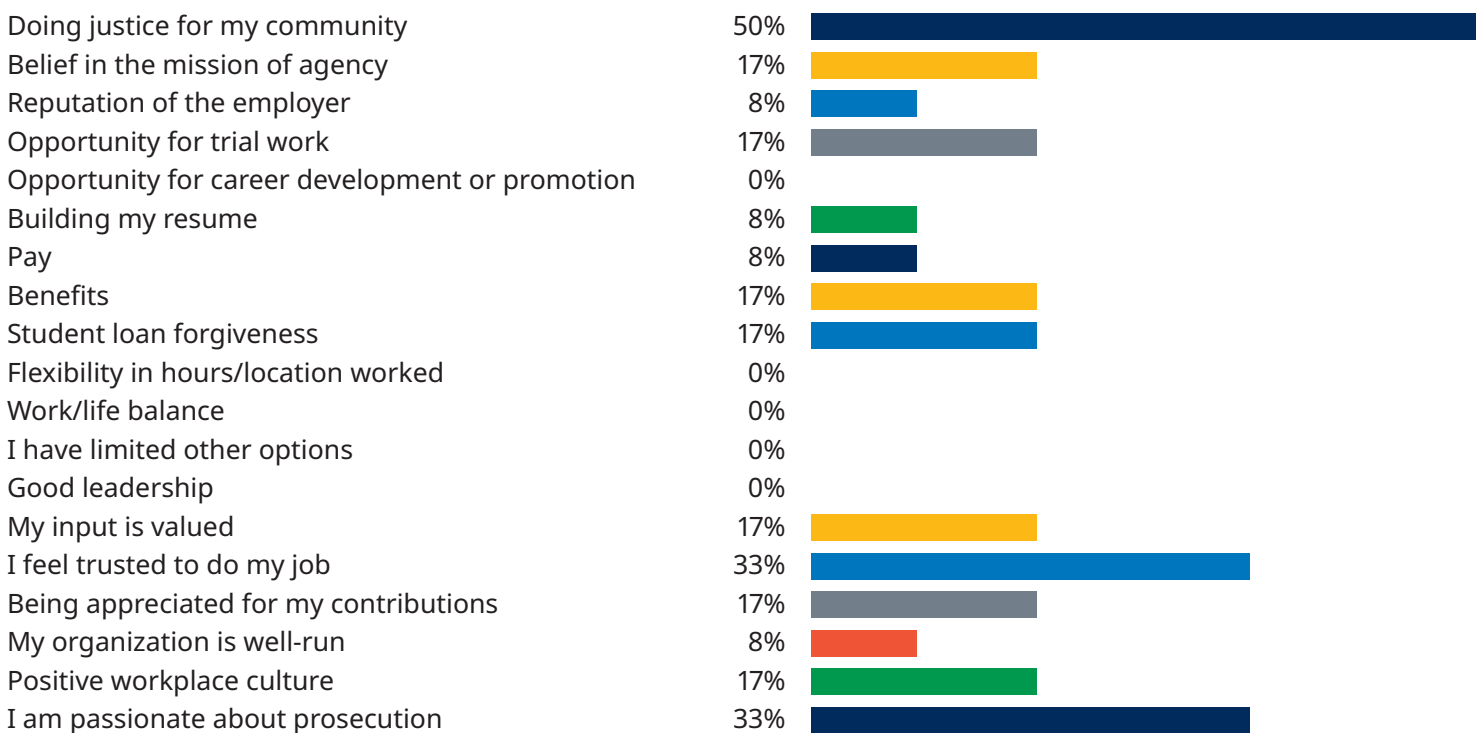
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

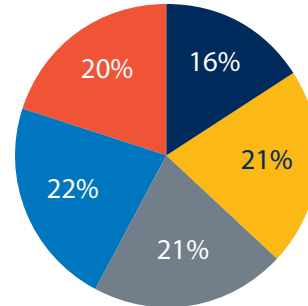

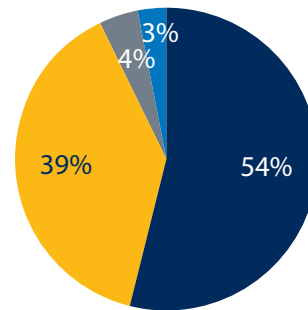

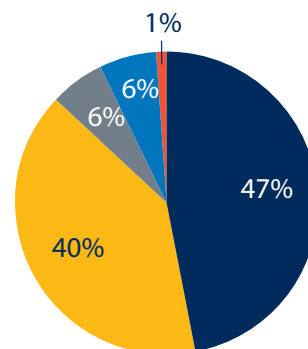

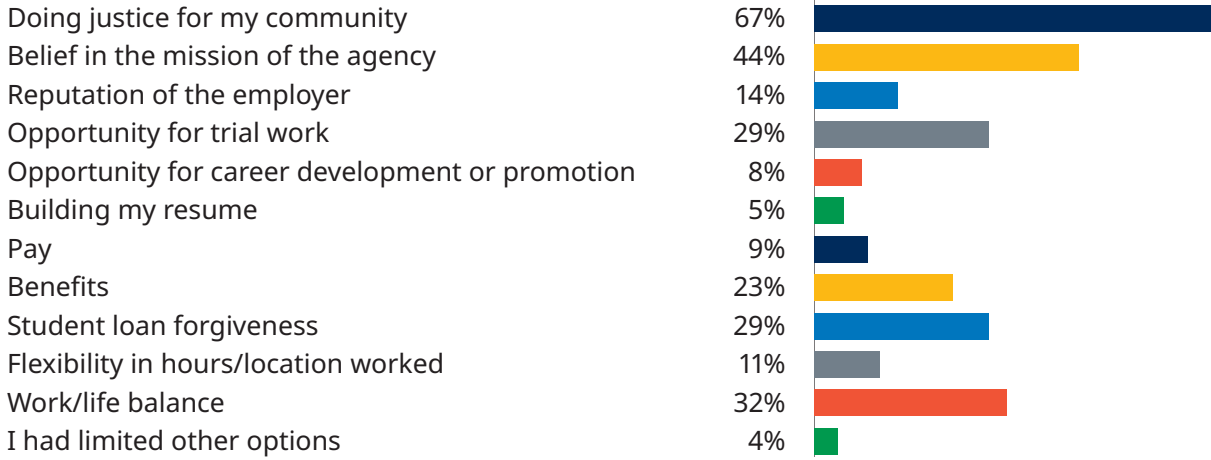

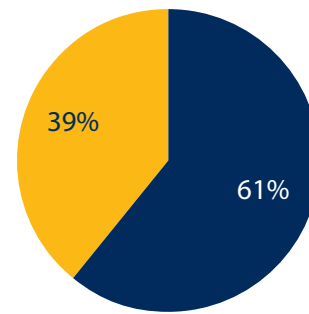

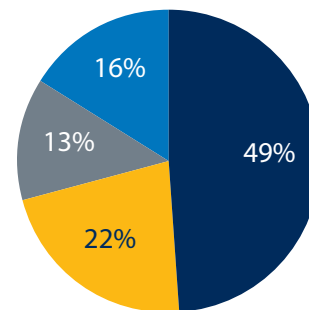

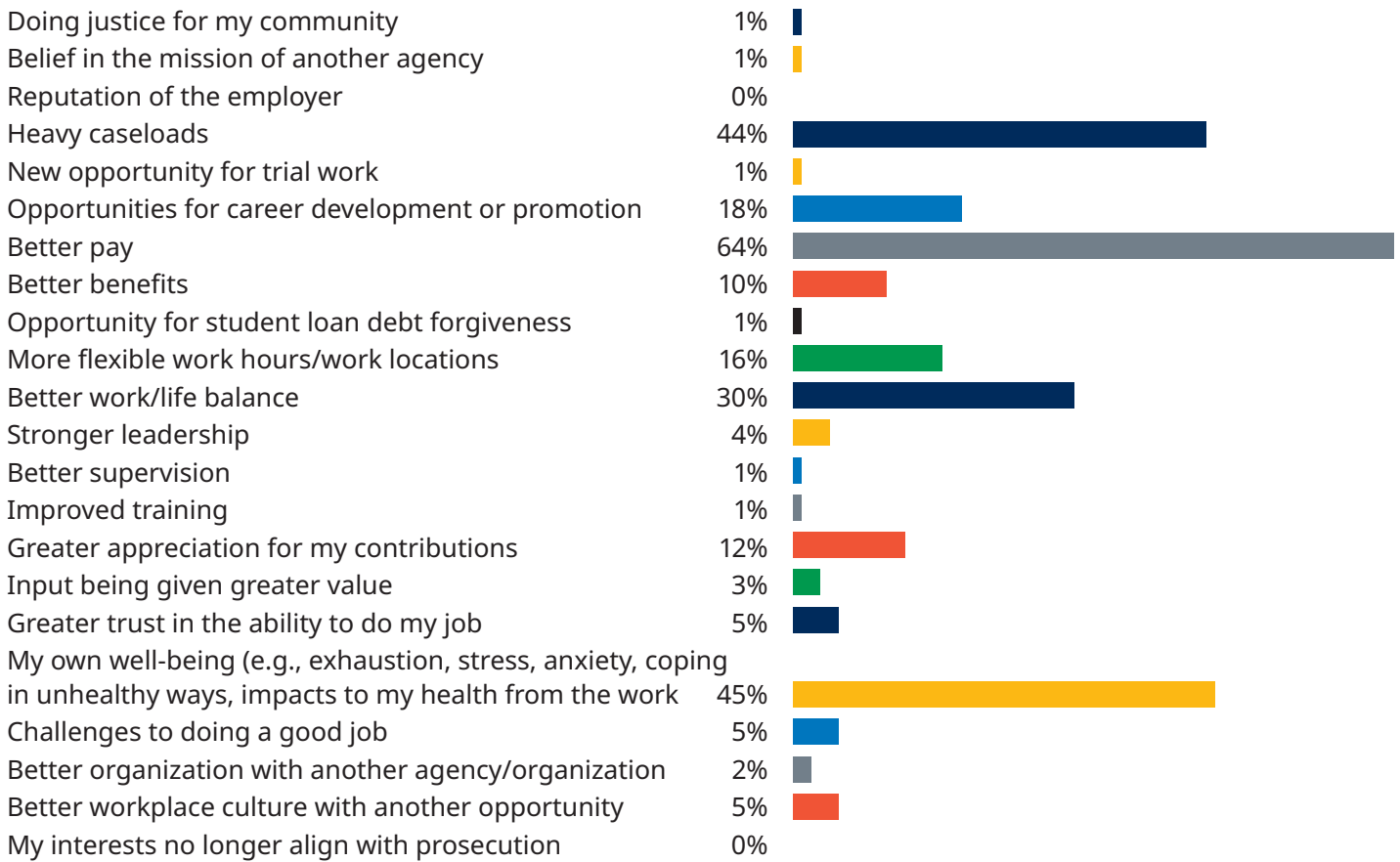

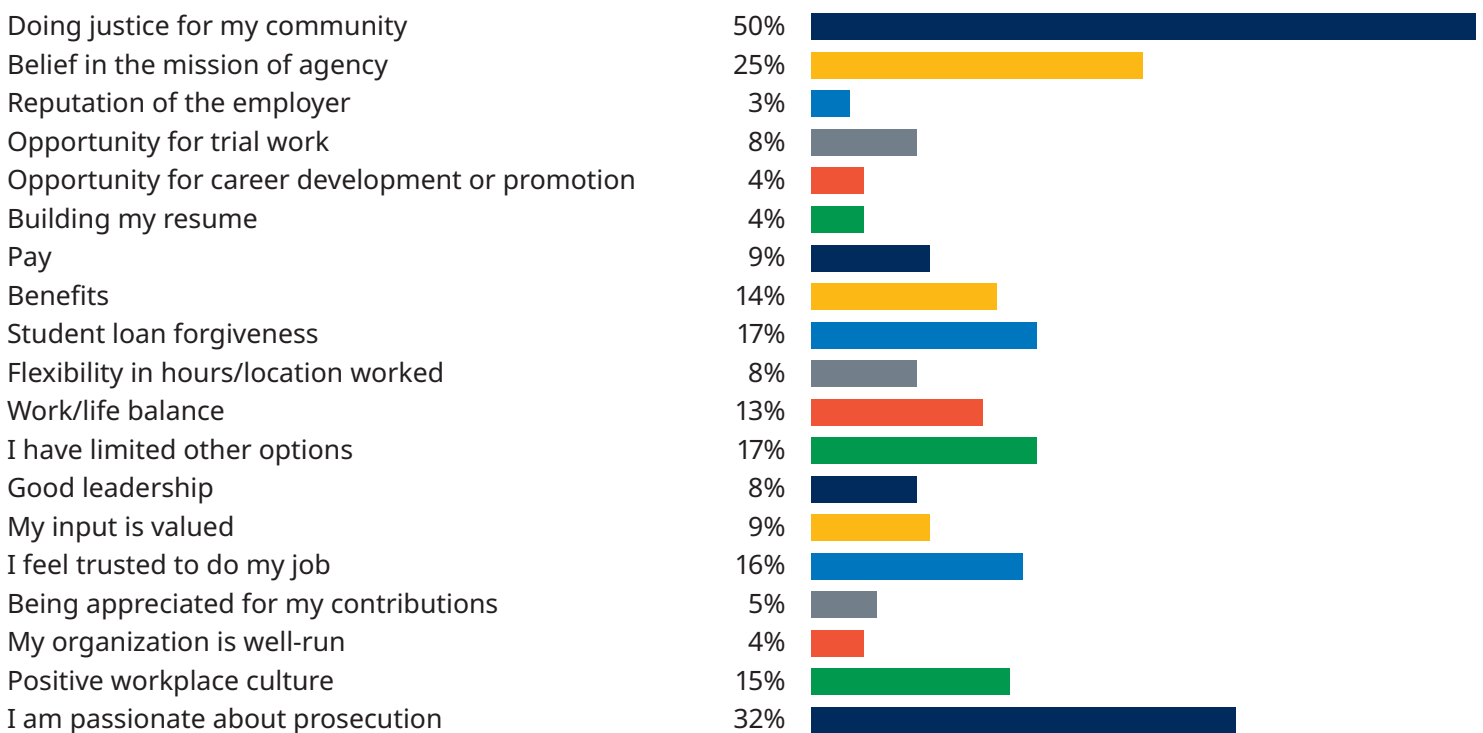
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?

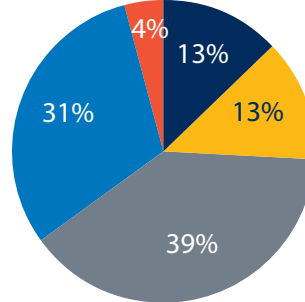

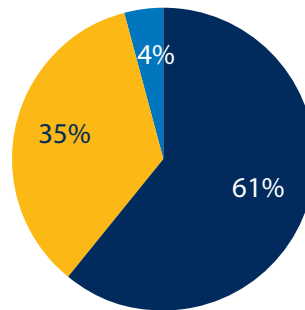

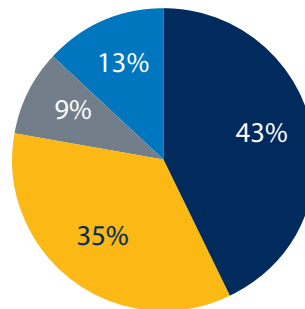

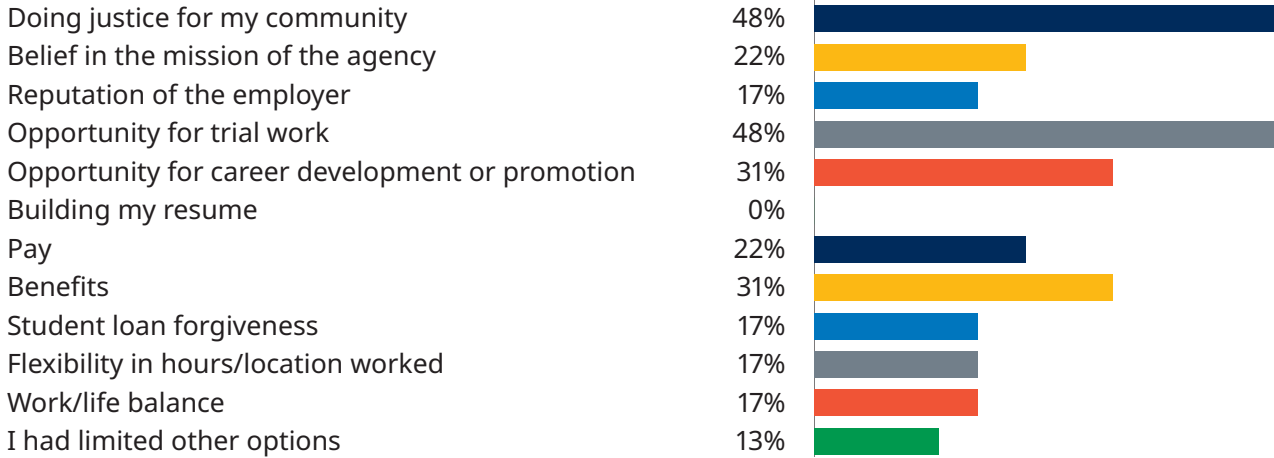

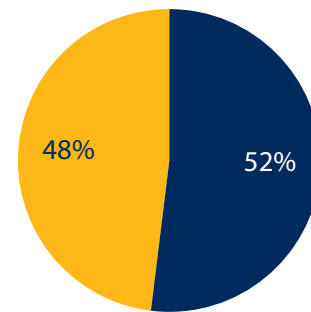

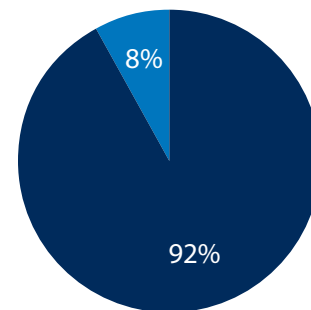

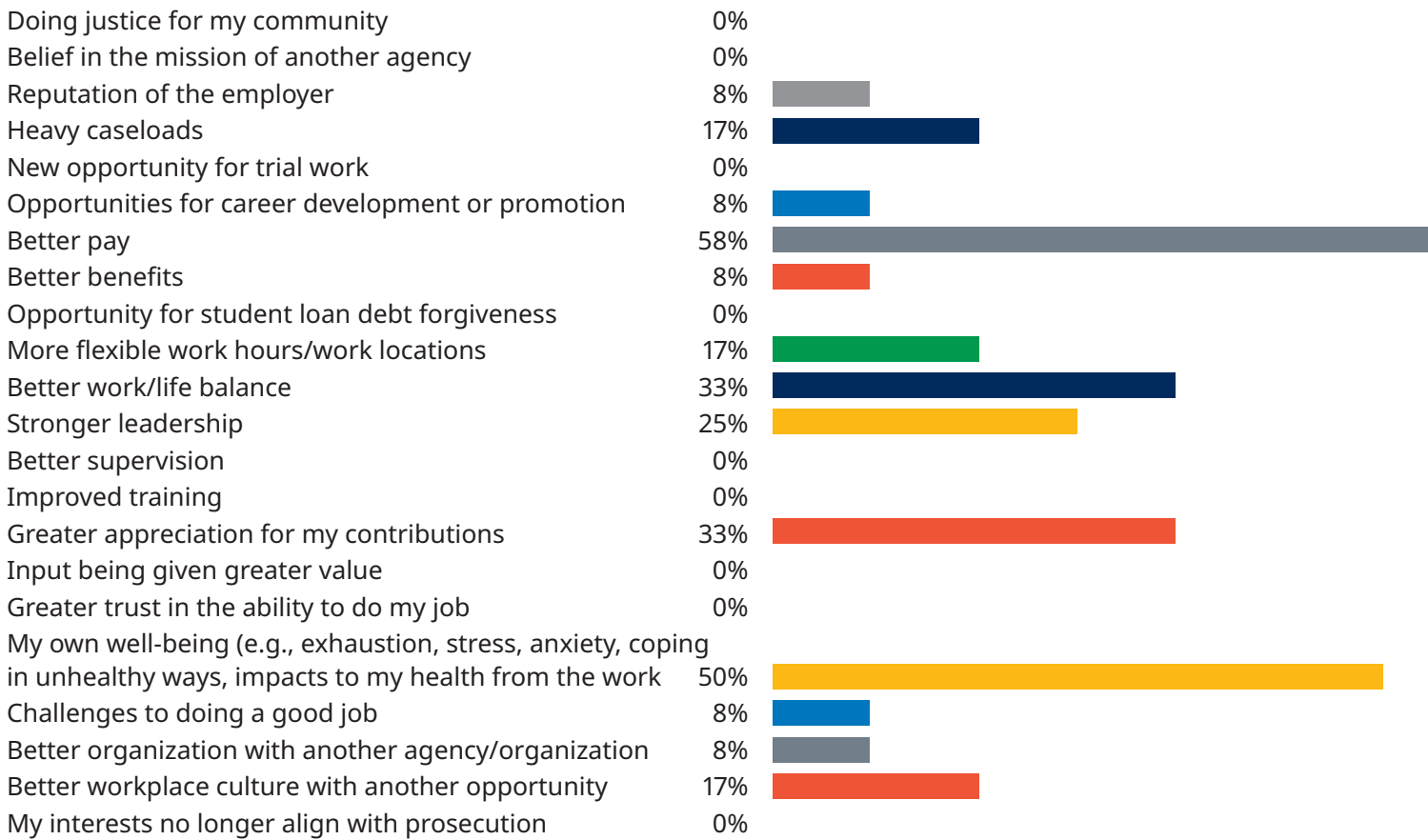

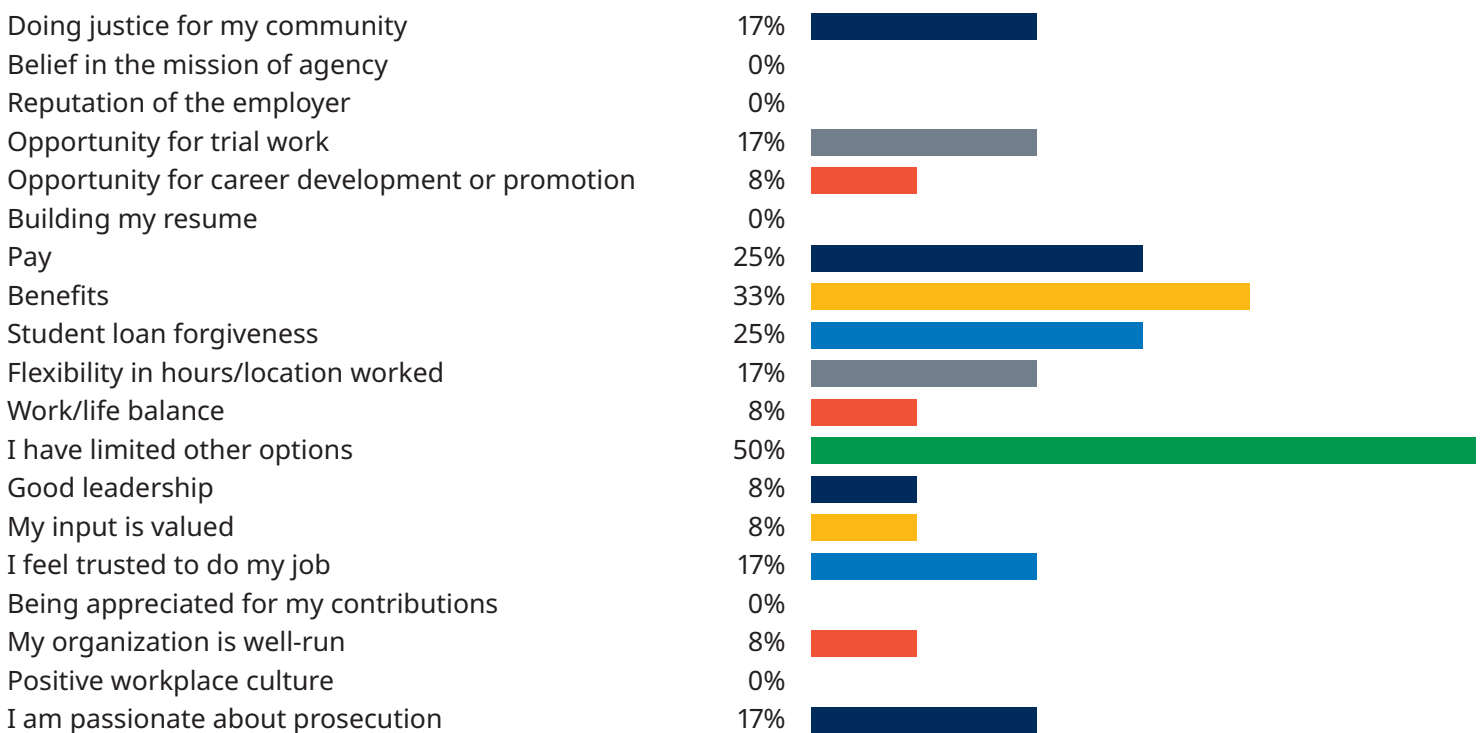
Q7. For those that have ever thought about leaving, what are the primary motivating factors?
