A Senior Deputy routinely tries the most complex cases, and provides lead direction to other professional staff in the prosecution of a variety of criminal and/or civil matters. A Senior Deputy District Attorney is an expert litigator with a high-degree of specialized knowledge in one or more of the most complex areas of criminal prosecution and exercises functional-lead supervision over assigned staff.

Ideal Candidate:

The ideal candidate will be a person of integrity with a passion for justice, a love of mercy, and an attitude of humility. They will have demonstrated their dedication to justice and victims by routinely trying hard cases, developing a reputation for professional excellence and compassion. Their experience will include complex trial work, *e.g.*, multiple defendant cases, life crimes, homicides, domestic violence, gang cases, or sex crimes. They will have experience working closely with law enforcement, reviewing search warrants and directing follow-up investigations. They must take initiative, be organized, and have excellent communication and relationship-building skills. The ideal candidate will also have experience in their personal or professional life as a coach, mentor, teacher, or leader.

Required Qualifications:

Minimum: Juris Doctorate degree from an accredited school of law, and five years of experience as an attorney in the practice of criminal or civil law.

Preferred: In addition to the minimum requirements, additional years of relevant professional experience as an attorney in the practice of criminal law, and experience mentoring, coaching, or supervising.

Special Requirements: Be a member in good standing of the California State Bar Association.
