

Director of Training

The Anne Arundel County State's Attorney's Office is seeking a highly experienced attorney to train new prosecutors and assist experienced prosecutors in keeping abreast of recent developments in criminal law. This position is located in Annapolis, Maryland.

This is a lateral position that requires:

1. A solid understanding of current Maryland criminal law, criminal procedure, and trial advocacy
2. Significant experience in prosecuting a variety of criminal cases, including jury trial experience
3. Ability to work closely with and mentor new and experienced prosecutors
4. Ability to write clearly and effectively
5. Ability to teach trial advocacy and legal concepts
6. Ability to train law enforcement academy and in-service classes on a variety of legal topics

The Director will develop and implement training programs within the State's Attorney's Office for both the Circuit Court and the District Court Divisions. These may include distributing synopses of recent appellate decisions, presenting guest speakers on topics related to criminal prosecution and professionalism, designing workshops on practical trial experience and improved presentation, recommending quality training programs and seminars for attorneys to attend outside of the office.

The Director will also assist in developing and implementing annual review standards for attorneys and will coordinate, upon request by a police department, the training of police officers.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have a minimum of 7 years of jury trial experience and be licensed to practice law in the State of Maryland. This will be a full time position but consideration for a part-time position for the right candidate will be considered.
